So Ends this day Thermometer 78.10 Lat By Obs 17.38

Tuesday September the 24 1839
Commencement of this day Calm at 10 O'clock
finished Painting the Stern boat with Black
Looking Weather in the eve the had a Lite air
from the same quarter

Middle Part Calm
Latter Part the same with Good Looking Water
So Ends this day Lat By Obs 17.1800
Long By Chron 87.14 15

Wednesday September the 25 1839
This day begins with Calm at 5 Lite breeze
from the East Headed SSE

Middle Part Wind the same and Ruff
Sea on Latter Part the fore stay fell down
Busy Employed in fitting a new one Saw
2 Hump backs and a Barge Saw 2 Hump backs
at 12 wore Ship to the North Eastward
So Ends this day Lat By Obs 17.57
Long By Chron 87.04

Thursday September the 26 1839
This day begins with Strong breeze from the East
at 6 finish the stay and set it up and carried
it way the Sea to the fore top was stay saw
2 Bugg and a large whalers

Maia Sail Saw Green Whales On our Lee Quarter
Jack for the same at 6 1/2 Load Larboard Boat
Foster Starboard Boat Got Stone in fastening
Lost Broadford the Boy and 3 Men Badly Hurt

them On Board went of and pasted to the same
to hale the being Most dead I Load the waste
Boat and Pick up the Cars and 3 Lost 1/2 of

Friday September the 27 1839

Lite breeze from the East at 1 O'clock Took
the whole of day Hide and Got breakfast
at mid then Got the bounded Pest as well as
Circumstances would Allow of at 5 Commence
Cutting On the whale

As the first Latter Part Same as the Middle
at Day Lite Call all Hands at 12 Got
the Head of and Part of his Boddy Saw 1 Ship
to Windward So Ends this day Lat By Obs 17.9
