 Sack are getting later also Bones broken So Ends This
 Day Lat by Off 17 00

Friday October 11 1839
 Commencement of this day Lite breeze from
 the Eastward Headed to the N at 6
 Shorten Sail Saw a on our weather Bow
 Boiling Headed to the South

Same as the first Latter Part Just Moderate
 And Pleasant at 5 Made Sail and wore ship
 to the SE Wind SE Saw a finback So Ends
 this day

 Long by Chro 36 42

Saturday October 12 1839
 Commencement of this day Lite breeze
 from the SE Headed SE at 4 O'clock
 Wore ship to the ESE Wind SE at 6 Shorten
 Sail

Middle Part Moderate and Pleasant

Latter Part at 5 Made Sail Saw a brigg on
 our weather Beam at 8 Wind Boffin and
 Lite Shores of Rain at 10 More Pleasant
 Over Head Saw a MBrigg enter Shaler on
 our Lee Beam So Ends this day a Perfect Calm
 Lat by Off 16 42
 Long by Chro 36 30

Sunday October 13 1839
 Commencement of these 24 Hours Squally
 Saw a brigg Enter at 2 O'clock Jack Ship
 to the Eastward Wind N

Middle Part Mod-
 erate and Cloudy Latter Part Moderate

At 5 Made Sail at 7 Saw a sperm whale
 Load at 10 Cum on Board Saw nothing
 More of him Saw a brigg on our weather Quarter
 So Ends this day Lat by Off 16 47
 Long by Chro 36 30
