Up a little Started the Works Saw a brig
Standing to the westward at 6 Squally Again

Middle Part the Same with Strong Squalls
Pots Glazed Had Cook down to Clean them

Latter Part Wind and Weather Much the Same
Pitched Overboard about 50 Barrels of Blubber
The Oil being all out Saw a whole brig a Head
Standing to the SSE with our 9. Ends this day
Lat by SK 15.58
Long by SK 36.15

Saturday October 19 1839
Commencement of this day Strong Gale and
Thick and Rany Heading to the SSE Wind
East at 6 Coold down On account of Rain
And for the Want of Blubber

Middle Part
Seavear Weather Weather of all Sorts

Latter Part More Pleasant at 10 Saw the Sun
at 12 Wind E Headed SSE Sat the Fore sail
and Double reefed Mainsail So Ends this day
Lat by Obs 16.44
Long by Obs 37.4

Sunday October 20 1839
This day begins with a Strong Breeze from the
E and Cloudy Headed to the SSE
More Moderate Wind ESE
Latter Part all Hands
Employed in Stowing down Oil 26 barrels and 19 Gallons
So Ends this with 1 Sail in Set
Lat by SK 17.38
Long by SK 36.42

Monday October 21 1839
Commencement of this day Cloudy and more
Smooth at 6 Stroke of Headed to the SSE
Wind SE at 8 O'clock Saw a Sail on our Starboard
Headed to the westward

Middle Part Much
the Same Latter Part Cloudy and Thick
with Lite Rain Shorten Sail Wind SE by E Jack
Ship So Ends this day
Lat by Obs 18.10
Long by SK 36.7

Tuesday October 22 1839
Commencement of this day Cloudy Weather
with a Moderate Breeze from the SE Headed
to the SSE with a Rane Storm

Middle Part
Stormy at 9 Down Ship Wind SE at 3 O'clock
Down Ship to the SSE

Latter Part Cloudy and
Moderate Mild Sail Wind SE Headed to westward
by at 12 Shorten Sail Thick and Rany So Ends this day
Lat by SK 18.23
Long by SK 35.58

Wednesday October 23 1839
Commencement of this day Heavy Swell from
the W and Cloudy Wind SE Headed to the SE Eastward

Middle Part Strong Gale and Heavy Rain at 10
O'clock the Wind Headed Round to W and from W to
I Took up the Boats

Latter Part Same But More
Pleasant Over Head up 40 of SE Last Thursday
I Scatcht the then with Heading Over a Cash
Sunday it began to Swell and Rain more getting
Worst Every day this day it is almost Squid to the
Pumpkin Loath a he Any way it is so hot
Scant like Good Hand
