Commencement of this day Wind and weather  
More Pleasant at 3 O'clock Made full sail and  
Heeded WNW at 6 O'clock Shorten Sail saw a  
Sail on our Lee bow

Middle Part Still More Pleasant

Latter Part More Pleasant weather Made all sail  
Wind SE Headed at 12 O'clock Spoke  
the Barge Minerva Capt Smith 250 Saw a Barge  
atna sehr on our Starboard beam So Ends this day  
Lat by Alt 18 13  
Long by Chron 36.22

Friday October the 25 1839  
Commencement of this day Pleasant at 4 Saw  
at Sail on our Starboard beam Breeze SE Headed  
at 6 Shorten Sail Headed to the Eastward

Middle Part Cloudy Wind from S to E & SE

Latter Part Cloudy at 6 Made full sail Headed  
to the Westward Wind Lite and Squalls of Rain  
Saw some flocks of fat Geese So Ends this day My Throat  
is Better  
Lat by Alt 17 23  
Long by Chron 36.20

Saturday October the 26 1839  
Commencement of this day Cloudy Wind Lite from  
ENE Headed to the North at 6 Shorten Sail and wore  
Ship

Middle Part Calm and Breezy

Latter Part Wind at 8 Headed ENE Saw 2 Sails  
on our weather bow at 11 the Barge Benth Cutting in  
Ends Close day with Lite breeze from the N E  
Lat by Alt 16 20  
Long by Chron 36.30

Sunday October the 27 1839  
Commencement of this day Lite breeze from the  
NE and S by E at 6 Shorten Sail  
Middle Part Breezy

Winds and Breezy Latter Part Breeze and Pleasant  
Wind at 8 Headed WNW Saw the 2 Barges a  
Sailing So Ends this day Lat by Alt 17 37  
Long by Chron 36.20

Monday October the 28 1839  
Commencement of this day Lite breeze from the  
ENE Headed to the North at 6 Shorten Sail Saw  
at Barge on our weather beam Headed to the S

Middle Part Moderate and Pleasant

Latter Part  
The same at 5 Made full sail at 6 Saw 3 Sperm Whales 7 Pairs  
on our weather quarter Took them to be Sperm Whales 6 to 8  
Miles going back to the N the next Rising there were  
3 Miles on our weather beam I saw the Whales settle  
within 20 minutes going back the next Rising there were  
2 Sperm Whales 7 Miles of Sperm Whales 7 Pairs Saw no more of them  
Took up the Boats Head to the North at 10 Saw White water  
Lighthouse Breaches and Sperm Whales on our weather quarter Took  
Ship for the same than I imagined to be humpbacks Saw  
2 Barges to windward one Barge to be cutting Lat by Alt 17 13  
Long by Chron 36.14

Tuesday October the 29 1839  
This day begins fine Pleasant and Good Sailing  
Saw 3 Sails to windward at 6 Shorten Sail

Middle Part the same

Latter Part same as  
the first Saw to Sail to windward 3 Barges ENE  
Headed to the N So Ends this day all well Lat by Alt 16 42  
except my self My Hand is not much better Long 36.24
