The ENE Headed to the NW Saw a hump back at 6
took in sail and went ship to the westward My hand
is better but Swell had as great the Ship's Keeper is
about the same

NW Saw a Barge on our bow beam Headed to the
SE at 6 ends this day

Sunday November 3 1889

Commencement of this day Breeze from

and went ship Middle Part Pleasant

same at 6 maid sail and went ship to the

South at 12 took ship to the South This
day my hand is better & ends this day Latt by 16 16.55
Long by 37.26

Monday November 4 1889

Commencement of this day Light breeze from
The NW Headed to the S at 4 saw a Dead whale
to windward 3 miles of land down a Boat pulled up
to it but found it was not worth taking along
side it had been dead to long

Middle Part Moderate
Headed to the S Eastward wind NW

Latter Part at 5 maid sail Light breeze of Rain
at 9 spoke a fish Boat said there was plenty of fish
were made for them but caught none he said
there was no whales so ends this fine and pleasant
my hand is getting better and the Ship's Keeper
also
