Commencement of this day like wind from the SW like thick and steady rain at 5 o'clock
More Pleasant Saw a brig sailing Saw the 2 ships at sun down Took in sail

Middle Part Calm

Latter Part More Pleasant Maid sail at 5
Saw the 2 Sisters Wind East Headed to the SW at 12 Took ship to the SW & ends this day

Long By Time 36.00

Wednesday December 4 1839

Commencement of this day fine breeze from the ESE Headed to the South at 6 Took in sail
Saw not any thing Took ship to the SE Eastward

Middle Part Moderate

Latter Part the Sun at 5 Maid sail Headed to the SE Eastward
Saw several other sail Ends without the least fog

Lat By Ab 18.2
Long By Time 35.50

Thursday December 5 1839

Commencement of this day brisk breeze from the SE Eastward Headed to the Eastward Saw 5 Merchant ships Headed to the SW at 4 Took ship to the SE at 7 Took in sail

Middle Part

Same as the first

Latter Part fine and Pleasant Wind SE Headed to the SE at 12 Took ship
Saw not any thing So ends this day

Friday December 6 1839

Commencement of this day fine and Pleasant Headed to the SE at 9 Took in sail 1

Middle Part Headed to the SE

Latter Part at 5 Maid sail and Took ship to the NW Saw 2 ships standing to the SE at 6 Saw not any thing at 12 Took ship to the SE wind Ends

Lat By Ab 17 55
Long By Time 36 22

Saturday December 7 1839

This day begins with fine breeze from the ESE Headed to the SE Eastward at 7 Took in sail
Saw 2 Merchant men

Middle Part the Sun

Latter Cloudy Saw a hermaphrodite and Sohn to Wandara at 9 Took the Wells 400 Hundred So ends this day

Lat By Ab 17.48
Long By Time 36.16

Sunday December 8 1839

Commencement of this day fine weather Wind SE Headed to the SE at 4 Took in and Took ship

Middle Part Pleasant

Latter Part Same Wind SE Headed to the South Saw a school of Porpoises and a Merchant ship So ends this day
