Commencement of this day Lite Breeze
from the ESE Headed to the E and S W
at 4 Took in Sail

Middle Part Moderate
And Cloudy Headed to the SSE
Took Ship at 8 to W Headed to Latter Part
The W Westward at 10 Saw a Sail Whaler
Steering to the SE So Ends this day Lat 18 9
Long 36 00

Monday January the 13 1840
Commencement of this day Brisk Breeze from
the East Saw 2 Sails to Windward Running at 3 o'clock
Took Ship to the SSE and got a Lunar by Measur-
ing the Distance between the ☾ and Moon
Which made the Long 36.17 thro 36.2
at 5 Saw a Whal ahead of the 2 vessels at half
Past 6 Got within 3 Miles of him Load for the Sam.
But saw nothing more of him Took up the Boats
Spoke the Richard Henry Leg Ellis 5 Months out 180
Sth the other brig was The Mexico She Rased the whale
Before Sun set she had the at all day Shorten
Sail

Middle Part Moderate Headed S E S
Latter Part fine and Moderate Headed to the W
Saw a Whal man ahead Wind ESE at 10 Took to
the SE So Ends this day Lat by Ob 18 20
Long by thro 35 44

Monday January the 14 Sea account at at half
Past 3 O'clock Took three Distances between the Sun
the Moon Taken to find the Long.

East Headed to the SSE at half Past three O'clock
Got a Lunar by measuring the Distance of the
Sun from the Moon Which made the
Longitude 35 34 thro 35.41 at 7
O'clock Took in Sail and wore Round

Middle Part Moderate and Cloudy
Latter Part the same Wind ESE Headed about So Ends
this Day Lat by Ob 18 03
Long by thro 35 56

Wednesday January the 15 1840
Commencement of this day Lite Breeze from
NE West to a Calm Headed to the E and W
Saw the Richard Henry a beam of us on the other tack
at 4 Took in Sail and wore Round
Middle Part the same

Latter Part same as the first 6 - saw a Merchant
Brigg Headed to the SE - Saw nothing else under
Heavens the weather fine and smooth So Ends
this day Lat by Ob 18.26
Long by thro 35 30

Thursday January the 16 1840
Commencement of this day fine Pleasant
and Breezy Moderate at 7 Took in Sail and wore
Round

Middle Part the same Wind ESE
Latter Part same as the Middle Wind W
Headed NW Saw a Diamond fish at 12 Took
Ship So Ends this Day

Long by thro 35 43
