

Friday February 14 1840

Commencement of this day brisk breeze from the S E Headed at 4 Land gets in sight of the Lee Quarter

Middle Part the same at 12

Downed iron Latter Part same as the first Wind E Headed at 11 Saw a Green Whale a Head going to the S. Heifer of a not fully skin but he was to clear to be fooled with. Loud but could not get up with him at 1 Took up the boat and back to the wharf E

Saturday February 15 1840

Commencement of this day brisk breeze from the S E Headed at 6 at 7 Struck 4 Porpoises and broke one iron

Middle Part brisk breeze from the S E at 10 O'clock got the latter by the Moon 5.42 & Long 33.52

Latter Part same as the Middle Headed at 10 Saw a Great Many Hooked and Smooth Fish S. Ends this day

Latter by DK 34.12 Long by the 34.25
A Point Variation Westward Strong Current to the NW

Sunday February 16 1840

Commencement of this day brisk winds from the S E Headed at 4

Middle Part Cloudy Latter Part much the same with a Moderate breeze from the S E at 9 PM Let the Lion Shedderson sail

Latter by DK 1.47
Long by DK 3.2 Long by DK 35.4 Long by the 35.52

Direction of Point Variation Current at 6.0 27 miles

Monday February 17 1840

Commencement of this day brisk breeze from the S E Headed at 4

Middle Part the same with a little shower of rain

Latter Part Moderate at 7 Took in the Quarter Boat to Repair & ends this day

Latter by DK 10.20 & Long by DK 36.26 Long by the 37.29
Current at 6.0 19 miles

Tuesday February 18 1840

Commencement of this day Wind Lite from the S E Headed at 4 The Captain on Deck of Duty

Middle Part the same Latter Part same as the first Employed in various duties & ends this day
Latter by DK 10.57 & Long by DK 37.59 Long by the 39.05
Current at 6.0 9 miles

Wednesday February 19 1840

Commencement of this day Moderate breeze from the S E Headed at 4

Middle Part The same at 4 the Top Off Parted Squally and wind Lite Latter Part Rather at 10 O'clock the Wind Still, & to the NW Ends Cloudy
Latter by DK 2.09 Long by DK 39.37
Long by the 41.11

Thursday February 20 1840

Commencement of this day Wind S E and Lite Headed at 4 Put out the boat

Middle Part Moderate Headed at 4 Latter Part Calm and cloudy & ends this day
Latter by DK 3.36
Current at 6.0 24 miles Long by DK 42.30
