Wind ESE Headed to the water of a Dark Dirty
Green

Middle Part Breeze more cloudy
Latter Part fine Pleasant weather with passing clouds
At 9 O'clock got a Letter Which made the Log
59.09. Hrs. 59.11 Lat by Ob 12.50
Long by Obs. 59.00
I. ends this day
Lat by Ob 12.20 Long by Ob 55.50

Saturday February the 29 1840

Commencement of this day fine weather at 4 O'clock
Made Barbadoes Bearing 24 Miles of SW at 6
South Point ESE 8 miles

Middle Part Wind at E
Headed NW at 5 O'clock St Vincent Bore W by NW
S Point distance 22 miles
Wind NW E to NW

Latter Part fine Pleasant
at 9 Kingston Bore SE 5
Miles got Letter later which made the Log 61.21
At 12 Went on Shore at the bottom and Glass Low
Several Sails I. ends this day Wind Sile and variable

Sunday March the 1 1840

Commencement of this day Lile Breeze from the
SE at 5 O'clock Came on Board with 3 Barrels of gun
Provisions 100 Coconuts 2 Pigst and 3 Chickens and
on Provisions of Eggs

Middle Part Breeze from
the East at 8 Headed NW by N

Latter Part More
Moderate and Pleasant I. ends this day
Lat by Ob 14.43
Long by Obs 62.35

Monday March the 2 1840

Commencement of this day fine Pleasant weather
Wind ESE Headed to the NW by W

Middle Part Equally
Latter Part More moderate saw a Brigg Headed
to the SE toward low 2 finbacks and a Great
Lot of birds a few Sprigs of Rock or gull Weed
the Carpenter is more comfortable I. ends this day
Lat by Ob 16.17
Long by Obs 63.26

Tuesday March the 3 1840

Commencement of this day Strong Breeze
from the NW Headed NW by W

Middle Part the same
Latter Part the same at 6 O'clock St Cruz
Bore to distance 10 Miles at 7 Toward
St John St Thomas and other small Islands
Wore in SE Headed NW by W. I. ends this day

Wednesday March the 4 1840

Commencement of this day fine Pleasant
weather at 8 O'clock Came to anchor in
St Thomas Middle Part the same
Latter Part Wind and weather the same arrived
at 6 Took in the Carpenter low Shore

Thursday March the 5 1840

Commencement of this day Wind SSE Head

Middle Part Moderate Latter Part the same
Wacker Employed in Painting and other Dec
