and Orion Flood Out at 8 Breeze on
Single Reef Ship Sailed with Saw Several Sails
going to seaward at 11 Heavy Squalls and
and fogged

Tuesday March 17 1840
Commencement of this day Strong Gales

At 6 O'clock came to and anchor in company
with the Mexico in 20 fathoms

Middle Part Strong
Land Breeze Latter Part Same as the first
At 9 O'clock the Orion came in and came to
So Ends this day

Wednesday March 18 1840

This day begins with Strong Gales

Middle Part
the Same Latter Part Strong Gales at 10
the Thomas Winslow came to and anchor Reported
it very difficult tide and also mistaken

Thursday March 19 1840
Commencement of this Strong Gales

Middle Part much the Same

Latter Part Same as the first So Ends
this Day

Friday March 20 1840
Commencement of this day Strong Breeze
At 3 O'clock the Ariadne came in

Middle Part Moderate Latter Part
the Same At 8 O'clock got under weigh
Sailed down the South Side of Pontine
So Ends this day

Saturday March 21 1840
Commencement of this day Light Breeze from the
E & S Sailing down the S Side of Pontine at 6
Cape Hope Bore at 15 miles under the new Light
and bent the Old one Shorter Sails and Flood
of

Middle Part Moderate at 3 Sack and
Flood in Latter Part Wind W & E at 12 O'clock
the Cape Hope Light distant 15 miles Saw
Several Sails So Ends this day
