Reef Foresail S. Ends this day

Wednesday April the 1 1840
Commencement of this Day More Moderate
Set Single Reef Mainsail and Foresail

Middle Part Calm Latter Part Light
Breeze from the SE Headed W Saw a Barque
Phaler on our Lee Beam S. Ends this day

Lat by Obs 28. 49
Thermometer 73. Water Long by Chron 78. 10

Thursday April the 2 1840
Commencement of this day Light Breeze from
the SE Headed W at 6 Took in Sails
Headed SE

Middle Part Wind E and Light

Latter Part Strong Breeze from the E Headed
SW at 8 o'clock Touched in the Stream
Thermometer 74. W at 64; at 10 Saw an English
Barque S. Ends this day
