 Latter Part at 8 O'clock Water 58° and
 Green Jack Ship to the NW Sat a close Reef Top-sail
 Ends Hauling and Rugged with Strong Gale
 At 12 66 Lat By Alt 88.10
 Long By DK 72.34 Long By Alt 68.55

Friday May 8 1840
 Commencement of this day Strong Gale from
 NW to NW Headed WSW at 2 Jack to the NW 66
 Water 70° at 8 Jack in the Top-sail
 Middle Part Same at 10 Jack Water 56°
 At 3 O'clock Saw a Bark Ship Headed to the Westward
 Wind at 5½ Headed by 8
 Latter Part at 7 Sat a close
 Top-sail Water 66° at 52 at 9 68° to 69° Jack Ship
 Wind at 8 to NW Headed 8½ to 9½ Ends
 with Strong Gale and Ruff with Passing Clouds
 Lat By Alt 87.5-2 Long By DK 72.44
 Long By Alt 69.5

Saturday May 9 1840
 Commencement of this day Brisk Gale
 From the NW Headed SE Water 68° at 7 Jack
 In the Top-sail Water 68°
 Middle Part Long Lulls
 At 10 Water 66°
 Latter Part Calm and Cloudy
 at 6½ 70° with a Large Swell from the Eastward
 at 12 Rainy Water 70° Laid down the Main-sail
 in consequence of breaking the Tackle
 Lat By Alt 88.09 Long By DK 72.02
 Long By Alt 68.22

Sunday May 10 1840
 Commencement of this day Thick and
 Rainy Wind 8 Headed W at 4 O'clock Jack
 at Bark Ship 15 day Out from New York
 His Long was 67.30 Ours was 65.30 at 8
 the Wind Lulled from 8 to 12 Heavy Tempe-
 rature from 12 to 6 Wind Lite from WSW and
 Pleasant Saw a Ship Headed E So Ends this
 W 58° Lat By Alt 89.09
 Long By Alt 66.00 Long By DK 68.56

Monday May 11 1840
 Commencement of this day Strong Gale Single
 Reef Split the Spencer and Bent the new one
 Water 58° Green Headed from NW to NW
 At 6 the Wind NW Jack Ship at 6½ Wind came
 Out to the NW with a severe Squall Headed
 to Jack in the Fore-sail Top-sail Balance Reef the
 Main-sail and Spencer Water 54° Middle Part
 Heavy Gale and Rainy Latter Part Same at 8
 Sat a Reef Fore-sail and double Reef Main-sail
 at 11 Sat a close Reef Top-sail Wind NW Headed
 NW Ends with Brisk Rain and Cloudy with a Lite
 Breeze Thermometer 50° Lat By Alt 89.12
 Long By Alt 66.45 Long By DK 69.21

Tuesday May 12 1840
 Commencement of this day Strong Gale and
 Cloudy with Lite Rain Thermometer 66° Water 50°
 At 6 Sounded 50 Water Jerry from Wind NW Headed
 Middle Part Moderate Wind at Headed NW
 Latter Part Pleasant Wind NW and Lite at 50 Water 50°
 Headed NW Water Green Bent the old Jib
 Ends Pleasant and Cloudy Lat By Alt 88.38
 Long By Alt 68.4 at 8 O'clock Long By DK 70.21
 At 11 at 4 O'clock from 8 to 4 it was calm
