

Thursday February 8th - 1925

Fine weather but a heavy sea
we started the works and finished
by 11:00 AM the whole lot the bottom
boat in on the house washed off
deck & set the watch so ends the day

Friday 9th

Fine breeze from the S and W
called all hands at sun rise turn
mence stowing down cleared
decks at 5 PM stowed down 58
barrels so ends the day

Saturday 10th

Worked all hands as usual and
sawmen set stowing down cleared
decks at four and washed off decks
stowed down about 30 barrels so goes
the birds

Sunday 11th

Employed in repairing the bottom
boat & light breeze from the W
steering by the wind heading to the S
and W nothing in sight so ends
the day

Monday 12th

Repairing the boat & at 10 AM
the ship & moving room of 1500
ton at 3 months out 300 lbs iron &
saw several grampuses but no
whales so ends the day

Tuesday 13th

Fine weather all this day
employed in mending the boat
& so ends the day

Wednesday February 14th - 1925

Light and fine weather saw sea
sail this day painted the L. boat
and repaired other damages &

Thursday 15th
Fine to S and W fine weather
saw a ship got for longitude
agreed with ours within 1 mile
but no fish in sight this day

Friday 16th

First part fine weather spread
the Brix (Columbus of New
London) 8 months out one whale
& saw grampuses first part
none in second part at 5 PM
deck top sails at night about reef
main top sail fore & main top
sail set so ends the day

Saturday 17th

Wind to the Westward but
to water short sail. Saw a ship
first part but did not speak
her rather short times so ends
the day

Sunday 18th

Strong gale from the W blowing
by night short sail nothing in
sight but times

Monday 19th

Strong breeze nothing doing
but eating and sleeping
