

Thursday September 16 - 45

Friday 17

This day fine weather light
airs. Weather fair at wind N.E.
N.E. steering N.W. saw a
plenty of fish but could not
catch any. Lat 4, 35
Long 39, 30

Saturday 18

This commences with light
winds from the N.E. steering
N.W. by all sail set, nothing
in sight. Lat 6, 33

Sunday 19

At this day terrible wind with
squalls of rain, sent several
boards of water overboard the sails
backwards and steering from
N.W. to N.E. as the wind blew

Monday 20

This is usual squalls of rain, and
calm. Lat 8, 30

Tuesday 21

This day commences with a fine
breeze from the N.W. steering
different courses on the port
wind. At latter part with rain
saw one sail steering N.E. Lat 9, 45

Wednesday September 22 - 10

This day commences with a strong breeze
from the N.W. steering N.W. by all
top sail set nothing of any consequence
Lat 10, 30

Thursday 23

Wind N.W. steering N.W. by all
and N.W. equally with rain, thunder
and lightning. Saw one sail steering
to the N.W.

Friday 24

This day commences with a fine breeze
from the N.E. steering N.W. by all
not so much rain as we have had
one sail in sight bearing N.W. steer-
ing N.W. nothing more of any consequence

Saturday 25

These 24 hours fine breeze from
Eastward steering N.W. by all
port part of the vessel with a very
little rain & repaired a fish
and bent it back out for repair

Sunday 26

First part rainy with the wind
N.E. steering N.W. middle fine weather
steering N.W. steering N.W. by all
latter part cloudy with a light wind

Monday 27

This day commences with a fine
breeze from the N.E. steering
N.W. by all, sent down the fore
top gallant sail repaired it bent
it again &
