

Friday August 7th - 1886

First part steering N.E. with all out that
middle part steering N.E. with all out that
and some grasshoppers to end the day

Saturday 8

This day begins with a fine wind from
N.W. steering N.E. with all out, middle part
calm, & saw several sharks, caused by some fish,
latter part light winds from the N.W.

Sunday 9

Fine weather with the wind N.W. steering
N.E. by E. saw several sail steering to the N.E.
at 2 saw grasshoppers rise for them, and some
porpoises to end the day

Monday 10

This day begins as usual with fine weather
and a N.W. wind steering N.E. first part
middle steering N.E. by E. at 2 P.M. saw several
Porpoises bearing N.E. by E. by compass Dist 15 miles
at 4 P.M. bearing W Dist 15 miles to end the day

Tuesday 11

At 11 this day a fine breeze from the N.W.
steering by the wind saw several Porpoises bearing
N.W. by compass Dist 50 miles at 8 P.M.
tacked to the W heading about W at 10 P.M.
with lightning to end the day

Wednesday 12

This day commences with a strong breeze
from the N.W. steering & middle part wind
light steering N.E. by E. at 6 P.M. saw several
Porpoises and Piked bearing N.E. by E. Dist 30 miles
tacked to the E at 11 P.M. and a boat went on shore

Thursday August 13th - 1886

First part laying off on on at foggy
at 1 P.M. altered our oil to 10 lbs at night
came on board and lay off on on at day
light went on shore and got our recruits
senses the day

Friday 14

This day commences with light winds
and rain, still laying off at foggy
at 8 P.M. made sail standing on
the wind to the N.E. to end the day

Saturday 15

First part light wind from the N.W. steering
N.E. by E. middle part strong wind from
N.E. steering N.E. by E. took in for top gallant
sail at 11 P.M. saw several
Porpoises bearing N.E. by compass Dist 15 miles
at 1 P.M. saw a Whiff bearing N.E. by compass
Dist 15 miles to end the ship to the N. This day
strong winds from Eastward

Sunday 16

Strong breeze from the Eastward at 11 P.M.
tacked to the N.W. steering N.E. by E. Dist
15 miles saw one sail of the weather at 1 P.M.
one tacked to the Eastward at sunrise N.W. steering
bearing N.E. by E. Dist 20 miles standing in for the
land to end the day

Monday 17

This day begins with light winds from the
Eastward standing on the wind to the N.
and E. at 6 P.M. saw several Porpoises to N.E. steering
N.W. at part W steering N.E. bearing N.E.
Dist 8 miles
