

Saturday September 28 --- 1846

First a strong breeze from the W. steering N.W. middle part squally with the wind from W to N.W. saw several sail. at 6 P.M. took in 3 sails & J & K

Sunday 29

This day strong breeze from the W. steering N.W. standing on the wind to the N.W. saw several sail. Lat 2.56 Long 17.00

Monday 30

Fine weather with the wind S and west steering by the wind S. board took on board saw 5 number of sail.

Tuesday 1

Wind and weather as usual fine steering by the wind S. board took on board saw from W to N.W. latter part W.

Wednesday 2

First part heading W by S with S. board took on board middle part heading W by S fine weather. Lat 2.25 Long 22.19

Thursday October 3 1846

This as usual strong breeze from the S and E steering on wind. S. board took on board heading from W by S to N.W. all sail out

Friday 4

Strong winds from the N. standing on the wind. S. board took on board steering N.W. by W. Lat 2.58 Long 23.41

Saturday October 3 --- 1846

Strong N.W. winds heading to the N. at 2 P.M. took in the J & K latter part heading N.W. by W. Long 25.00

Sunday 4

Wind N.W. clear sky fine weather steering by the wind heading about N.W. by W at 8 A.M. took a squall from the S and W single reef fore top sail. Lat 2.34 Long 26.25

Monday 5

Fine weather, wind N.W. heading about N.W. with the sail out but first squally rain

Tuesday 6

This day commences with the wind N.W. squally with rain, steering by the wind heading N.W. by W nothing in sight of any consequence. Lat 2.42 Long 28.43

Wednesday 7

Pleasant weather with a fine breeze all sail set steering by the wind heading about N.W.

Thursday 8

All this day strong breeze from the E. steering to S by the wind at 6 P.M. saw a few sail latter part light winds. Lat 4.58 Long 30.48

Friday 9

This day commences with a light breeze from the Eastward heading to the S by the wind about 4 P.M. latter part wind hauled to the N. heading N.W. fine weather but nothing in sight. all hands employed in ships duty till 10.30. Lat 5.00
