

Monday November 1st 1845

This day begins with westerly gales of wind steering by the wind under close reef. Top sail and fore sail at 10 AM in the fore sail & top sail, heading to the N. at sunrise called all hands to press out off decks especially with rain at 7 AM. saw whales three got breakfast & began the two quarters boats, fastened with one iron in 8 minutes it came out chased a while and came on board, whales going. N.W. this day sails with light winds from the Northward till 33.45
day 13.43

Tuesday the 2^d

First part light winds from the N. steering by the wind with all sail out, the first time for 12 days, latter part wind increased to with rain

Wednesday 3

This day commences with strong gales from the N.E. lashing to under close reef. No top sail & fore & M. spencer, at 5 PM. took in the mast head sheet down the hatches & latter part wind freshened to the N.W. & W. carrying at 2 AM. one of the staterooms & shifted in sea knocked the cabin down in the fore & aft part of the ship & all below times

Thursday 4

Strong gales from the N.W. lashing to under under short sail. At 8 AM. steering N.W. & a heavy sea on

Friday November 5

Strong breezes from the N.W. steering N.W. under close reef. At 10 AM. with fore sail at 10 AM. took in fore sail & came to the under close reef. At 10 AM. fore & M. spencer at sunrise called all hands maid sail put the mast head on the cabin and began clearing decks & repairing damages on

Saturday 6

Friday commences with a fine breeze from the N. steering N.W. & a heavy swell on reaching the beach near under latter part till 4 PM. repairs of rain all the day employed in repairing damages on at 7 PM. steering N.W. latter part light winds from the Northward

Sunday 7

Fine weather wind N.W. steering N.W. & a heavy swell from the N.W. all this day employed in ship's duty repairing damages

Monday 8

Wind N.W. steering N.W. thick cloudy weather saw a hundred & at 29.23

Tuesday 9

This day commences with the wind N.W. steering N.W. with all sail out, fine weather latter part wind freshened to the N.W.

Wednesday 10

Wind N.W. steering N.W. rain at 6 PM. wind increased at 11 PM. saw a bark steering on the wind to the Eastward
