

Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> 1847

First part fine weather, employed in making at 6 P.M. took one aboard in at daylight commenced cutting to sun

Thursday 27<sup>th</sup>  
First part employed in cutting at sun down all in with the water, strong breeze from the Northward, standing on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> so ends the day

Friday 28<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather, wind standing to the S. on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup>, this day employed in making off at 11 A.M. commenced pumping water for stowing so ends the day  
 38.10

Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> March 1847  
This day commences with fine weather, we being out and standing down at three P.M. cooled down at 4, cleared up decks stowed down the head about 25 P.M. at 5 P.M. raised all hands & commenced standing down so ends the day

Sunday 30<sup>th</sup>  
First part standing at 2 P.M. washed off decks at night 11 in sail. fine weather so ends the day

Monday 31<sup>st</sup>  
Light winds from the Northward standing to the Eastward, employed in ship's duty at one P.M. it was an hour there was a large spinnaker within half a ship's length off going to the windward against opposition made sail light to the wind, saw nothing more of him at daylight at 9.55 day 59.02

Thursday March 5<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with strong westerly winds standing by the wind. Topping for a while saw 2 grampuses & killers at sunset took sail. last usual better part rainy at 3 P.M. day 59.31

Friday 6<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather at 1 P.M. wind shifted to N.W. standing to the S. at 4, topped to the N.W. this day topped at night for her single reef Main topsail & foresail latter part strong breezes from the S.

Saturday 7<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather with a strong Easterly wind standing to the S. and W. saw finches & a great number of birds, 2000, latter part standing W.

Sunday 8<sup>th</sup>  
Strong Easterly wind standing to the N.W. under topsails and courses, saw porpoises at sunset took in sail cloth reef Main topsail & fore spinnaker, standing latter part must increase

Monday 9<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales from the S.W. began to make cloth reef Main topsail & fore & Main spinnaker at 8 P.M. took in the Main part 10  
 39.55  
 59.55

Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup>  
This day commences with strong gales from the S.W. going to under short sail. 4thward took on board a plenty of birds around of different kinds so ends the day  
 39.15

Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales from the S.W. going to under short sail. 4thward took on board a plenty of birds, latter part fine weather
