

Monday April 5 1897

First part fine weather wind W standing on the wind with all sail set heading W middle part the same, latter part 35.8 by 59.00 strong strong breezes from the N.W.

Tuesday 6

Commences with strong westerly winds laying to under short reef main topsail, fore and aft spencers heading W on the starboard tack this day employed in repairing the Boat latter part wind freshened to the N.E. a heavy swell from the N.W. toward

Wednesday 7

Strong breezes from the N.E. with a heavy swell laying to under short sail. lat 35.00 employed in repairing the Boat, long 51.09 latter part fine weather

Thursday 8

Fine weather light wind from the N. a heavy swell & saw a plenty of Birds, this day employed in repairing the Boat. lat 35.13 long 56.22

Friday 9

Commences with fine weather middle part strong breezes from the Northward standing on the wind, all hand tacks aboard still at work on the Boat

Saturday 10

Strong breezes from the N.W. laying to under short sail. middle part wind freshened to the N.W. steering by the wind to the N.W. part squalls of rain lat 37.16 long 51.59 wind on the Boat

Monday April 11 1897

Commences with strong westerly winds with a heavy swell from the sea. Mistletoe part calm lat 36.39 long 55.00 latter part strong breezes standing by the wind

Tuesday 12

Strong breezes from the W standing under double reef top sails at four PM a whole broad water within a ships length lat 38.38 long 59.39 took in the fore top sail. short reef the A freshened to the wind on the 4th heading N.W. whole evening W of W latter part strong breezes nothing in sight

Wednesday 13

This day commences with strong N.W. wind with squalls of rain at midnight took in sail for the night short reef all sail and the A spencers on the starboard lat 35.10 long 53.30 took first steering N.E. by N

Thursday 14

First part fine weather, wind W standing on at sundown took in sail for the night at this day finished repairing the Boat at night put her over hull lat 37.35

Friday 15

Fine weather with the wind W standing on at night standing two watches, & nothing in sight yet lat 38.30 long 51.37 latter part wind freshened to the Northward

Saturday 16

Light winds from the N and W standing on at night middle part strong wind from the Eastward steering by the wind on the 4th
