

Saturday April 17<sup>th</sup> 1847

This commenced with fine weather wind N<sup>W</sup> standing with wind S<sup>W</sup> board took on board at six P<sup>M</sup> sailed to the N<sup>W</sup> lat 33.52 long 38.59 latter part the same

Sunday 18

Strong S<sup>E</sup> winds steering by the wind with in sight of any consequence lat 33.91 long 37.52 latter part the gib stay

Tuesday 19

Strong winds from the N<sup>W</sup> standing on the wind heading E under single reef lat 33.45 top sails and courses latter part wind increased double reef topsails standing on the N<sup>W</sup> tack long 36.35

Wednesday 20

Commenced with strong winds from the N<sup>W</sup> standing on the wind S<sup>W</sup> board took on board heading E<sup>W</sup> under double reef top sails and courses set latter part lat 33.42 wind increased took in the main sail and close reef the topsails took the fore sail bying to on the S<sup>W</sup> board took equalled of main so ended the day

Thursday 21

First part strong to breeze S<sup>W</sup> with wind at one P<sup>M</sup> wind shifted to the N<sup>W</sup> steering E by N under single reef lat 33.38 reef close and close reef of the main part fine weather but a strong breeze steering N<sup>W</sup> this day employed in repairing the main sail set up the gib stay and bent the gib etc long 34.05

Thursday April 22 1847

Strong breeze from the Westward with squally of rain steering N<sup>W</sup> with all sail set at 2 P<sup>M</sup> sent up the fore top sea the at sail bent it we saw one sail off our lee steering to the N<sup>W</sup> latter part lat 31.58 long 32.3 fine weather

Friday 23

Commenced with a strong N<sup>W</sup> wind steering N<sup>W</sup> by E with all sail set lat 29.53 latter part wind steering E by N long 29.50

Saturday 24

Fine weather wind N<sup>W</sup> steering E with all sail set this day rigged out the fly top on set up the head stays etc set one sail latter part steering E by N lat 28.28 long 27.52

Sunday 25

Light winds from the Southward steering E by N with all sail set lat 27.49 long 26.55 wind shifting heading from E by N to E by S

Monday 26

Fine weather wind from S to S<sup>E</sup> steering by the wind middle part squally with rather latter part strong breeze lat 27.25 Double reef the topsails, took in the gib and spanker long 23.21

Tuesday 27

Strong southerly winds steering by the wind under double reef topsails and courses at eight P<sup>M</sup> turned out the fore reef set the gib and spanker long 20.57

Wednesday 28

Fine weather with a strong breeze lat 26.26 steering E by N latter part light air long 19.11
