

Thursday May 13th 1891

This day commences with light winds from the N.E. steering on the wind ^{at 11.31} heading from S.W. to S.E. at 2 P.M. day 5.39
saw a porpoise, latter part wind and weather the same

Friday 14

Fine weather, light breeze, heading from N.E. by W. to E. in the night, saw porpoise ^{at 11.18} latter part heading E. by S. day 5.05

Saturday 15

Commences with light winds from the N.E. steering on the wind heading from N.E. by E. to E. latter part the same ^{at 11.58} day 5.57

Sunday 16

Wind and weather about the same heading from E. to S. by S. in strong ^{at 10.51} cloudy current day 9.25

Monday 17

Fine weather wind S.W. steering by the wind, saw a porpoise latter part ^{at 9.32} strong breeze day 5.08

Tuesday 18

Commenced with strong breeze from the N.E. steering by the wind, latter part the same ^{at 8.18} ^{at 11.29} day 5.09

Wednesday 19

Strong winds from the N.E. steering by the wind, passed through a strip of water very thick full of jelly or bright spots ^{at 7.08} look as tho the water was on fire day 9.33

Thursday 20

Strong southerly wind steering by the wind heading about S.W. stuck into ^{at 5.15} dark water day 3.51

Friday May 21st 1891

Commences with strong southerly wind heading S.W. stuck into ^{at 5.58} dark green water at 6 P.M. saw red bat ^{at 5.58} got no bottom in 150 fathoms

Saturday 22

Thick cloudy weather wind N.E. steering by the wind, still in dark green ^{at 5.58} water saw ^{at 1.28} fish of different ^{at 1.28} kinds latter part clear sky

Sunday 23

Fine weather wind S.W. first part steering on the ^{at 8.26} shallowest tanks at 2 P.M. to the eastward day 8.26

Monday 24

Fine weather steering by the wind on the ^{at 9.23} tanks at 2 P.M. to the southwest heading S.W. by W. latter part to the eastward day 9.23

Tuesday 25

Wind and weather the same steering on the wind; saw a finback and a quantity of drift-stuff ^{at 9.43} day 9.43

Wednesday 26

Thick cloudy weather first part calm at 2 P.M. at light breeze ^{at 11.11} steering on the shallowest tanks heading from S.W. by S. to S.E. by E.

Thursday 27

Light air steering by the wind heading S.W. at four P.M. ^{at 9.59} this day a heavy snow from the southward day 9.59
