

Thursday June 17th 1837

This day commences with fine weather
wind steering on the wind lat 8. 21
making a 3rd course long 5. 19

Friday 18th strong winds from
the southward steering on the foreland
tacks, at 5 P.M. saw finbacks lat 9. 39
but no sperm whales long 3. 39

Saturday 19th Wind and weather
the same, nothing in sight, lat 11. 11

Sunday 20th strong southerly winds
with squalls of rain, saw finbacks lat 11. 40
long 1. 30

Monday 21st wind and weather as
usual steering by the wind heading
of W by N at 6 A.M. steering N.W. lat 13. 42
saw Whalers long 10. 00

Tuesday 22nd strong breezes with
squalls of rain, saw Whalers at sunset
steering for the night single reef top
sails fore sail, the spencer at nine lat 15. 31
at 11 A.M. reef the topsails to
in the fore sail set the fore spencer

Wednesday 23rd strong S.W. winds
with heavy squalls beginning to rain at 10 A.M.
saw 3rd spencer on the
foreland, tacks saw 2 finbacks lat 16. 55
at sunrise steering N.W. under the
topsails and fore sail to enter the bay

Thursday 24th strong winds from the
N.W. with heavy squalls of rain, and rain
at 1 P.M. reef the topsails to in the
fore sail set the 3rd spencer and
to the wind on the 2nd tacks heading N.W.
so ends the day lat 16. 55
long 2. 50

Friday June 25th 1837

Commences with strong easterly wind, stea-
ring on the wind, tacks on the foreland
single reef topsails at sunrise close reef
3 sails latter part steering N.W. lat 16. 19
long 2. 41

Saturday 26th Wind and weather the
same, at 1 P.M. saw a sail, steering
to the N.W. This day set the main sail 16. 19
top Sallant sail steering by the wind long 3. 54

Sunday 27th generally, saw several
at three A.M. caught four porpoises, lat 16. 59
saw finbacks the latter part fine weather long 3. 55

Monday 28th
First fine weather over board but rather squa-
lly at night top in sail as usual, lat 16. 54
latter part calm long 3. 55

Tuesday 29th
This day commences with fine weather, saw
several sail, Merchantmen, but no whales
Wednesday 30th lat 17. 22
right side from the land, saw
several sail steering to the N.W. long 4. 42

Thursday July 1st 1837
light winds, at 1 P.M. spoke the Bark
Janet of Westport 11 months ago lat 17. 22
saw, latter part strong winds, saw finbacks lat 17. 22
long 5. 11

Friday 2nd strong breezes, saw several
and finbacks lat 17. 20
long 5. 11

Saturday 3rd
Fine weather with light winds saw one
sail and finbacks without number,
caught 2 porpoises
