Fine weather, light winds, steering N.W. with all sail set. this day employed in packing. Beasts

This day employed in scraping the stomachs and skinning them, Wind N.W. steering N.W. latter part some squalls, so ended the day

Fine weather as usual, steering N.W. with all sail set. saw grampuses this day employed in ships out

light winds with squalls of rain, wind N.W. steering N.W. by N, saw grampuses

Strong breeze with squalls of rain, steering N.W. by N

Strong Easterly winds with squalls of rain steering N.W. with all sail out. 10 miles the day

Wind and weather the same, steering N.W. nothing in sight latter part light winds

Commences with light winds from the Eastward steering N.W. at 11.00 saw a sail

Light winds steering N.W. by N, saw a sail steering to the N.W. at 12.00 PM took in the top gallant sail came to the wind with main yard. a back at daylight saw land - Martin's map rocks and Trinidad Bearing N.W. per compass Dist 30 miles steering N.W.

Saturday 21

This day commences with fine weather, one boat a fishing at the N part of Trinidad, at four came on board without much success, mid'dle part steering N.W. saw several sail. latter part fine weather etc

Commences with fine weather wind N.W. steering N.W. with all sail. set. this day employed in ships duty

Monday 23

Fine weather, saw humbirds, first part steering N.W. by N at 8.00 PM took the Bark President of Westport 13 miles out 250 latter part steering N.W. by the wind. shipward tack on board heading to the Southward
