Commences with fine weather wind ^W at 1 P.M. steering to the Southward. Saw Sunfish, Birds &c. & ends the day

Wednesday 8

Commences with wind steering ^W at 1 P.M. and porpoises at sundown took in sail for the night. Last reef top sails and spencers.

this day commences with fresh gale laying to under short sail

Thursday 9

Commences with fresh gale with rain begin to under short reef top sails and spencers heading ^W at 1 P.M. took in the Waist Boat at 11 A.M. More ship heading of Southward tack on Breeze

Friday 10

Strong Breeze, but moderating at 2 P.M. Put the Waist Boat on the Chais, making the most hands the latter part fine day

Saturday 11

Fine weather but rather foggy, wind at latter part strong breeze from the ^W at night steering by the wind under single reef top sails and fore sail.

Sunday 12

Commences with strong westerly winds steering by the wind at 2 P.M. spars the ship 6000 miles of Logwood bar. Left Jones 30. months out 2000, the latter part calm with a heavy swell from the ^W, & ends the day

Monday December 13th 1827

This day commences with a light wind from the Westward steering ^N, & saw a Shark at 10 A.M. saw finbacks, & fine weather
Left 38.10

Tuesday 14

Fine weather steering to the Northward saw a plenty of Finbacks, at sundown took in sail for the night heading ^N at night
Left 38.25
Day 19.25
latter part calm

Wednesday 15

Strong westerly winds steering on the wind to the North saw porpoises
Left 38.25
Day 19.25
ends the day

Thursday 16

Fine weather steering by the wind saw flying fish and a Sunfish &c.
Left 38.50

Friday 17

Fine weather as usual, nothing in sight but Finbacks
Left 38.25
Day 19.26

Saturday 18

Nothing in sight worth mentioning, this day steering to the ^W at night came to the wind
Left 38.35

Sunday 19

Fine weather steering ^N, saw Finbacks porpoises &c. at 11 A.M. sent a porpois latter part steering ^W
Left 36.22
Day 19.37

Monday 20

Strong winds from the ^W steering ^W saw Finbacks porpoises at 10 in sight came to the wind steering tack to the ^W on board heading ^W by ^W at daylight hooked to the Eastward
