

Saturday February 19 1848

This day commences with fine weather first part wind. At 6 AM wind hauled to the S. & then to the Westward, saw a great number of Birds, one turtle and a porpoise. latter part wind & steering S by W. Lat 34.46 Long 74.00

Sunday 20

Strong N. & N. winds steering S by W at sundown took the sail for the night came to the wind. S. & then to the Westward, saw a great number of Birds, one turtle and a porpoise. latter part wind & steering S by W. Lat 34.55 Long 74.50 this day foggy

Monday 21

Strong N. & N. winds first part steering S by W this day thick smoky weather at night took in sail as usual. latter part foggy Lat 35.00 Long 75.00 saw a porpoise & turtle & porpoises etc

Tuesday 22

This day thick foggy weather standing on the wind, saw porpoises turtle and a porpoise. Birds without number this day Lat 35.00 Long 75.00 Strong breeze from the Northward

Wednesday 23

Strong N. & N. wind standing on the wind under short sail. latter part sailing Lat 35.05 Long 75.05

Thursday 24

Strong breeze with rain and fog at 5 PM spread Bark (Charleston) 16 months out S. & W. latter part wind hauled to the N. Lat 35.50 Long 75.20

Friday 25

Wind S by W at sundown to the Westward saw one sail. latter part wind hauled to the N. & then to the Westward Lat 35.50 Long 75.20

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Bark Cumberland Cruising on the River La Plata Ground

Light airs from the N. & steering S by W at night took in sail as usual Lat 35.36 Long 75.00 this day saw Killers chased the boats without success

Sunday 20 This day commences with light winds and squalls of rain first part and then in chasing Killers at sundown saw a sail bearing S by W at night. P.M. the fog & rain cleared on from the N. & then to the Westward at 2 o'clock took in the N. & then to the Westward Lat 35.36 Long 75.00

Monday 21

This day commences with light airs from the N. & then to the Westward. at 2 P.M. backed to the Westward this day a heavy sea running from the N. & then to the Westward. latter part strong fog & rain with squalls of rain and wind Lat 35.36 Long 75.00

Tuesday 22

Typically with rain at 1 P.M. saw porpoises but could not tell what they were this day wind S by W latter part fine weather Lat 35.36 Long 75.00

Wednesday 23

Fine weather saw two sails at 2 P.M. spread Bark Yarnum of Plymouth 16 months out S. & W. latter part light winds from the Westward Lat 35.36 Long 75.00

Thursday 24

Light airs from the Eastward fine weather standing to the Northward saw porpoises etc Lat 35.36 Long 75.00

Friday 25 Fine weather, wind S by W standing on the N. & then to the Westward saw porpoises and Birds without number Lat 35.36 Long 75.00
