

Monday April 14 1848

Light air from the E. N. E. steering by the
wind heading to N. by E. with 8th sail cut
a heavy swell from the Southward Lat 10.56
Long 32.39 latter part the same

Tuesday 15 First part
Calm, at four a light breeze springing
up from the N. W. steering N. by E. Lat 10.47
this day ended with a light breeze Long 32.44
from the Southward

Wednesday 16 Light breezes from
the Southward fine weather steering N. by E.
Lat 9.12 Long 32.51 latter part N. by E. and black fish

Thursday 17 Light winds and
squalls of rain steering N. by E. and then sail
from the S. of this day wind (E) Lat 8.51
Long 32.51

Friday 18 This day commences with fine
weather wind (E) steering N. by E. nothing in
sight worth mentioning Lat 8.23
Long 32.55

Saturday 19 Light winds as usual
from the E. steering N. by E. saw two Boats
this day employed in turning in and getting
up the Marine Rigging, at five A.M. Lat 8.02
Long 32.59 saw Lord Fernando Hernandez bearing
E. 1/2 N. for Comps Lat 35 Miles, at 6 steering
N. by E.

Sunday 20 Light winds from
the E. steering N. by E. Middle part squalls
with rain, wind changing to latter Lat 8.51
Long 33.24 part Wind V. E. saw one sail

Monday 21 Fine weather wind V. E.
steering N. by E. saw one sail & latter Lat 8.53
Long 33.26 part wind increased

Tuesday April 18 1848

Berried to St Thomas W Indies

This day commences with a fine V. E. wind
saw a lot squalling with rain, steering N. by E.
saw a great number of birds and fish Lat 1.25
but can't now at 6 of M. saw Black planes Bonob.
ish did not hear of latter part strong breezes

Wednesday 19 Light wind steering N. by E.
at 11 down to the mouth of the Lake Lat 25.10
but over more to the North of it, latter part 37.17
part sailing Thursday 20 Light winds

and squalls of rain steering N. by E. Lat 37.57
latter part 1.11 M. by S.

Friday 21 Wind and weather the same
steering N. by E. nothing in sight worth
mentioning, water rather grey latter part sailing

Saturday 22 First part of this day rain
wind (E) steering N. by E. Middle part
clear sky with a fine breeze Lat "

Sunday 23 Fine weather clear sky wind
V. E. steering N. by E. nothing in sight worth
mentioning got an observation of the sun Lat 3.29
Long 33.30

Monday 24 Fine N. E. wind steering
N. by E. this day clear sky pleasant weather
saw porpoises about two Lat 4.13
Long 33.36

Tuesday 25 Thick breezes from the
N. E. with squalls of rain steering N. by E.
this day quiet a heavy sea on Lat 5.39
Long 33.30

Wednesday 26 Fresh gales from the
E. N. E. steering N. by E. rather Lat 7.30
thick smooth latter part squalls Long 33.30
of rain and wind
