Monday July 21st

Commences with light breezes, winds from
S.W. to N.W. steered for Cape Cod & Middle part
calm and baffling winds at N.E. latter light
winds at S.W. and pleasant steered S. one sail in
sight. All hands employed variously
Lat by Ch 40.59 N. Long by Account 49.20. W

Tuesday July 22nd

Commences with light breezes at S.W. and
pleasant saw Black Fish Lanes and got
4 fish & steered S. Middle and latter brisk
breezes at W. and pleasant saw Black Fish
growing quick didn't lower. All hands
employed variously
Lat by Ch 41.27 N. Long by Choc 46.28. W

Wednesday July 23rd

Commences with a brisk breeze from
S.W. steering for Cape Cod S.E. Nothing
in sight. Middle part the same latter part
a fine breeze at W. steered S. one sail in
sight. Employed variously Boiled out the
Black Fish
Lat by Ch 41.46 N. Long by Choc 43.28. W

Thursday July 24th

Commences with a brisk breeze at W
steered for Cape Cod S. one sail in sight
Middle part light steered S.E. latter
part light wind at W.S.W. steered S.E. & S
saw nothing but one sail. All hands
employed variously
Lat by Ch 42.04 N. Long by Choc 40.58 W

Towards The Western Islands

Friday July 25th

Commences with light breezes at W.S.W. and
fine pleasant steering for Cape Cod S.E. & S
at 6 P.M. Signified with an American Ship
down to the Western Middle and latter part
fresh breezes at S.W. steered S.E. & S one sail
in sight the Watch employed variously
Lat by Ch 41.22 N. Long by Choc 37.11. W

Saturday July 26th

Commences with a fresh breeze at S.W.
steering for Cape Cod S.E. & S one sail in
sight Middle and latter strong winds at
W.S.W. and squally steered S.E. & S under
moderate sail, the watch employed
variously
Lat by Ch 41.22 N. Long by Choc 37.28 W

Sunday July 27th

Commences with strong winds from
W.S.W. steering S.E. & S under two reef
topsails and fore sail at sunset left
by the wind heading S.W. Middle part
by by latter part steered S.E. saw one sail
Lat by Ch 40.50 N. Long by Choc 31.16. W

Monday July 28th

Commences with a fresh breeze at W.S.W.
Ship heading S.E. & S several sail in
sight Middle part strong winds and squally
with heavy showers of rain Ship under
short sail latter part light winds
at W. at 6 A.M. saw the land the top of Cape
at the point 11 A.M. saw what we call Thorpe
Whales Lanes and chased 3 hours couldn't
tell what they were
