maneuvering Lat by Ob 28.41. N Long by Chron 30.37

Tuesday August 26th

Commences with light winds and raining
from S to S.W. Ship standing to the
westward At 4 P.M. saw several large
Sperm Whales at 5 lowered Lusenad and
killed one Whale at 7 P.M. took the Whale
a long side and took in sail. Middle
part fresh winds and squally at daylight
Commenced with cutting Latter part strong
winds at S.W. attended with a tempest and
shivers up rain All hands Employed
cutting No Ob



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Wednesday August 27th

Commences with fresh winds at S.W. Employed
cutting At 5 P.M. hauled the case up the side
and was all ready to bale it and both case straps
parted and down it went like a fallow steven
Middle part light winds at S.W. Ship heading
W. Latter part light winds at S.W. saw Nothing
but one sail Employed Reeling

Thursday August 28th

Commences with light hailing airs Nothing
in sight Employed Reeling Middle and Latter
part much the same

to the Westward At 4 P.M. finished Reeling Middle
part squally with lightning Ship under short
sail heading W. Latter part strong north winds
at S Ship heading S.E. saw several sails

Lat by Ob 38.13. N Long by Chron 32.27. W

Saturday August 30th

Commences with light winds at S Ship heading
S.E. Nothing in sight Employed Coopers Oil
Middle part light heading S. Latter
part light and hailing from S.E. to S Ship
heading S to S.E. saw sail in sight
Employed Coopers Oil
