Sunday August 31st

Commences with light winds at 8th & 9th ship
& sail in sight, middle and better part
light winds at 8th ship heading 88th & 8th ship
in sight saw Flores South dist 30. Miles
Lat by Ob 38,49. N Long by Ob 29,60. W

Monday Sept 1st

Commences with light airs at 8th ship
heading 88th & 7th sail in sight at 3 P.M.
spoke Ship Warren of Terceira 30 days out
15 lbs Sperm Oil middle and better part
light winds at 8th ship standing on opposite
tacks Sazul dist 8 Miles employed Coopering
oil.

Tuesday Sept 2nd

Commences with light airs at 8th ship working
to Sazul. Middle part squally and hailing
and about 14 hours the rain fell in torrents
Lat part Calm the tower 10 Miles Dist
at 10 A.M. went on shore.

Wednesday Sept 3rd

Commences with light hailing airs
at 4 P.M. returned on board the ship
middle part light winds at N.N.E. & 8th ship
sailing off and on at Sazul. At 7 A.M. Delivered
1,474 lbs Sperm Oil to be sent home better
part fresh breezes at N.E. off and on at Sazul

Thursday Sept 4th

Commences with light winds at N.N.E.
At 1 P.M. came on board all ready for sea
steers to the N.W. Middle part brisk winds
at N.E. steers N.W. by N. better part light
winds at 8 to 9 steers N.N.E. saw several
sail employed murely
Lat by 38,58 N Long by Ob 30,25. W

Passing about the Western Islands

Sunday Sept 5th

Commences with Calm employed setting up
head rigging murely the rain rather part
fresh winds at 8th W and squally Flores in
sight dist 20 Miles
Lat by Ob 39,40 N. No. Ob

Saturday Sept 6th

Commences with strong winds and hailing
and the rain falling in torrents at sunset
the wind N.N.E. and fine Flores Dist 8 Miles
Middle and better part light hailing airs
and Calm several sail in sight and Flores
Dist 12 Miles employed murely
Lat by Ob 38,59. N. No. Ob

Sunday Sept 7th

Commences with light hailing airs and Calm
several sail in sight and Flores Dist 15 Miles
at 6 P.M. spoke Ship Benjamin Morton of
Orleans 14 Months out 1,600 lbs Sperm Oil. Middle
part Calm. better part light winds from S.E. &
8th ship heading 8th W on sail in sight
Lat by Ob 38,25. Long by Ob 31,35. W

Monday Sept 8th

Commences with light winds at 8th & 8th ship
heading 8th W. Middle part Calm better part
hailing airs at 8 & 9 sail in sight and Flores
employed setting up rigging
Lat by Ob 38,35. N Long by a correct 31,25. W

Tuesday Sept 9th

Commences with hailing airs at 8 & Middle
and better part Calm with showers of rain
employed murely. several sail in sight and
Flores Lat by Ob 38,30 N Long by Ob 31,15. W
