Thursday Sept 18th

Commences with light winds at E. steering
S. Nothing in sight. Middle and Latter part
light airs and Calms & sail in sight
Employed variously. Painting tarney Carpentering
&c &c Put by Ch 26.51. N. Day by Ch 27.50. W

Friday Sept 19th

Commences with light winds at N.W.
steering S by W. All drawing sail. At
Middle and Latter part the same saw
Nothing Employed variously
Put by Ch 25.17. N. Day by Ch 27.48. W

Saturday Sept 20th

Commences with light winds at N.W.
steering S by W. Middle and Latter part
the same at daylight saw Black Fish
lowered and got 2 Fish. Employed variously
Put by Ch 23.44. N. Day by Ch 27.17. W

Sunday Sept 21st

Commences with light winds at N.W.
steering S by W. All drawing sail. At
Middle and Latter part the same saw Black
Fish gaining quick didn't lower
Put by Ch 22.16. N. Day by Ch 27.00. W

Monday Sept 22nd

Commences with light winds at N by W.
steering S by W. All drawing sail. At
Middle part light winds at N to N.E.
Latter part light winds at N.E. steered
S by W. saw Nothing Employed variously
hoiled out the Black Fish Carpentering
Tarring Painting &c &c
Put by Ch 20.50. N. Day by Ch 26.45. W

Tuesday to Fine Sept

Thursday Sept 23rd

Commences with a brisk breeze at N.E. steering
S by W. Middle part the same Latter part light
winds and varying from N to E. saw Nothing
Employed variously Carpentering Tarring rigging
&c &c Put by Ch 18.19. N. Day by Ch 26.40. W

Wednesday Sept 24th

Commences with light winds at E. N.E. steering
S by W. All drawing sail. At Middle and Latter
part hailing winds from E. N.E. to E. S. and
squally with overcast weather. steered
S by W. saw one sail. Employed variously
Put by Ch 16.41. N. Day by a count 26.30

Thursday Sept 25th

Commences with light airs and Calms at E.
Middle and Latter part light winds at
N.W. and overcast steering S by W. saw
Nothing Employed variously
Put by Ch 14.50. N. Day by a count 26.23. W

Friday Sept 26th

Commences with light winds at N.E.
with a heavy swell coming from the
North and thick overcast weather. Middle
part hailing winds from E. N.E. to S.W.
with a plenty of rain ship under short
sail Latter part all sorts of weather
winds from E to S.W. attended with squalls
and Calms ship working to the South and
sail in sight Employed variously
Put by Ch 13.53. N. Day by Ch 26.42. W
