Saturday Sept 27<sup>th</sup>

Commences with squally weather with rain  
the wind from S.W. to W. Ship working to the South  
Middle part strong winds with big squalls  
and showers of rain from W to S.W. Latter part  
fresh breezes at S.W. Ship heading S by W to  
S.S. All prudent sail set saw nothing  
of any account Employed warily  
Lat by Obs 11.53. N Long by account 14.18. W

Sunday Sept 28<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light winds from S.W.  
to W.S.W. Middle and latter part light  
breezing winds from S.W. to W. Ship  
working to the South Nothing in sight  
Lat by Obs 10.19. N Long by account 15.10. W

Monday Sept 29<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light bapling winds  
from S.W. to W.S.W. Middle part light winds  
from W to N. and squally attended with  
heavily shower of rain steered S.W. Latter  
part light bapling and squally with rain  
saw one sail. All hands employed working  
Lat by Obs 8.59. N Long by account 15.12. W

Tuesday Sept 30<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light bapling winds from  
N.E. to S.W. Middle and latter part bapling  
winds and calms with showers of rain  
& sail in sight. Employed warily  
Lat by Obs 8.10. N Long by account 14.56. W

Wednesday Sept 31<sup>st</sup>

All the 24 hours light bapling winds and  
calms with showers of rain saw 2 sail  
Employed warily  
Lat by Obs 7.25. N Long by account 14.23. W

Towards the Line 1851

Thursday Oct 1<sup>st</sup>

Commences with light winds at N.W. steering  
S.W. Middle part calm latter part light bapling  
winds from S.W. to W.S.W. Ship working to the  
S.S. sail in sight. Employed warily  
Lat by Obs 6.50. N Long by account 14.18. W

Friday Oct 2<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with a strong breeze from  
S.W. to W. and squally weather steered S.S. to  
S.W. Middle and latter part strong winds  
and pouring from S.S. to S.W. and the rain  
falling in torrents. Ship standing on  
offenit tacks to make latter part saw nothing  
Lat by Obs 6.20. N Long by account 14.18. W

Saturday Oct 3<sup>rd</sup>

Commences with squally weather and  
the winds varying from S.S. to S.W. no  
recursion to the rain. Ship standing on  
offenit to take advantage of the winds  
Middle part the same. Latter part strong  
winds from S.S. to S.W. Ship on offenit tacks  
saw nothing. Employed in Ship's duty  
Lat by Obs 5.53. N Long by account 15.27. W

Sunday Oct 4<sup>th</sup>

Commences with strong winds at S.W.  
heading S.S. Middle part strong winds  
from S.S. to S. Ship heading W.S.W. to  
S.W. Latter part light winds at S.S. heading  
S.S. by S. Lat by Obs 4.55. N Long by account 15.20. W

Monday Oct 5<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light winds from S to S.W.  
Ship heading S.S. to S. part in Ship steering N.  
Middle and latter strong winds from S to S.W.  
Ship heading S.S. by S to S. Employed warily  
Lat by Obs 4.22. N Long by account 13.37. W
