Friday Oct 30th

Commenced with light airs at N.E. Ship
leading S.E. & S. Middle and Latter part
the same. saw nothing but one sail and
Finbacks. Employed in breaking out Board
and caulking it.
Lat by Obs 40.07. S Long by Chron 4.34. S

Saturday Oct 31st

Commenced with light winds at N.E. Ship
leading S.E. & S. At 2 P.M. passed Range of London
of Gales leading S.E. & S. per compass. Middle
part fresh breezes at N.E. by S. Ship leading
S.E. & S. Latter part fresh winds at N.E. and
overcast Ship leading S.E. & S. All sail set
nothing in sight but Finbacks
Employed in Ship's duty
No Lat by a count 40.25. S Long 7.58. S

Saturday Nov 1st 1851

Commenced with fresh breezes at N.E. Ship
leading S.E. & S. Middle part strong winds
from N.E. with thick rainy weather
headed S.E. & S. All prudent sail set
Latter part from 5 to 10 A.M. strong winds
at N.E. with thick rainy weather at 10
the wind shifted to the N.W. and cleared
up fine pleasant weather one sail in
sight. steered S.E. & S. All drawing sail set
Lat by Obs 40.18. S Long by Chron 11.55. S
