Commenced with a fresh breeze at W & W and fine pleasant weather steering S by E per compass Middle part much the same, latter part fresh breeze at W and squally steered per compass S by E. saw nothing but Finbacks

Monday Nov 2nd

Commenced with strong winds at W and squally steered S by E. All drawing sail Middle part latter part strong winds from W to S W attended with hard squalls and showers of rain steered S by E to S E. All prudent sail set saw nothing.

Lat by Obs 38.35. N. Long by Obs 19.46. E

Tuesday November 3rd

Commenced with strong winds at S W and squally with rain steered S E E. Middle part fresh breeze from S W. Latter part light winds at W S W steered S E E. All drawing sail set saw nothing but Finbacks Employed manly.

Lat by Obs 37.54. N. Long by Obs 23.05. E

Wednesday Nov 4th

Commenced with a fine breeze at W S W steering S E E. Middle and latter part light baffling winds and calms from S W to S E Ship leading to the Eastward saw nothing but Finbacks Employed manly.

Lat by Obs 37.32. N. Long by account 25.50. E

Commenced with light baffling winds and calms at S W saw several Whales Mr. Made them out. Several Whales going quick to the North the wind backing up at the same time from the S E. steered for the Whales at 5 lower yet near enough to Dart to no purpose chased the Whales till run down and gave them up Middle and latter part light baffling winds from S to S W Ship leading from S E to S. one sail in sight Employed in Ship duty.

Friday Nov 7th

Commenced with light baffling winds at S E Ship leading S E E. one sail in sight. Middle and latter part strong winds from S E by S Ship leading S W to S E. saw nothing Employed in Ship duty. Lat by Obs 37.54. N. Long by Obs 28.12. E

Saturday Nov 8th

Commenced with strong breezes at S E Ship leading S E E. Middle part light winds and calms. Latter part variable winds from W to S W at 4.10 led a hard squall at S W it blowing a complete gale shortened sail steered S E by E. All prudent sail set saw nothing. Lat by Obs 39.12. N. Long by Obs 30.58. E

Sunday November 9th

Commenced with fresh gales at S W inclining to moderate steering S by E. All prudent sail set. Middle part light winds from W S W to W N W. Latter part fresh gales at W S W steering S by E. All drawing sail set saw nothing.
