Commences with fresh gales at N.W. steering
S.E. by E. All drawing sail set. Middle and
batter part fresh gales at N.W. steering S.E. by E.
& sail in sight. Employed in Ship's duty
Lat by Obs 39° 31'. S. Long by Chron 59° 53'. E.

Tuesday Nov 11th

Commences with fresh gales at N.W. steering
S.E. by E. All drawing sail set & sail in
sight. Middle part the same. Batter part
strong winds from N.W. to S.E. with thick
rainy weather saw nothing. No Obs
Lat by account 39° 35'. S. Long by Chron 44° 19'. E.

Wednesday Nov 12th

Commences with strong breeze at S. Ship
standing S.E. & with overcast weather. Middle
part light winds at S.E. Ship heading S.E. by E.
Batter part light winds from S.E. to S. Ship
standing off her tack saw nothing but one
sail. Employed in Ship's duty
Lat by Obs 38° 14'. S. Long by account 45° 30'. E.

Thursday Nov 13th

Commences with light airs at S. Ship heading
S.E. & one sail in sight. Middle part light airs
from S. to N.W. Batter part light winds
at N.W. steering S.E. by E. saw nothing but
one sail. Employed in duty
Lat by Obs 38° 47'. S. Long by Chron 48° 37'. E.

Friday Nov 14th

Commences with a light breeze at N.W.
and fine pleasant weather steering S.E. by E.
& Ship in sight steering the same. Middle part
variable. Batter part strong winds from N.W. to S.W.
steering S.E. by E. saw nothing
Lat by Obs 39° 14'. S. Long by Chron 53° 08'. E.

Saturday November 15th

Commences with strong winds at S.W. steering
S.E. by E. All paydant sail set. Middle part light
winds at S.W. Batter part light airs from S.W. to N.
steering S.E. by E. saw nothing but Firebacks. Employed
nearly. Lat by Obs 39° 10'. S. Long by Chron 56° 08'. E.

Sunday November 16th

Commences with light airs and Calms. Nothing
in sight. Middle part light winds at N.W.
Batter part fresh gales at N.W. and pleasant
steering S.E. by E. to S.E. All drawing sail
set. Lat by Obs 39° 27'. S. Long by Chron 59° 45'. E.

Monday Nov 17th

Commences with fresh gales at N.W. steering
S.E. by E. Middle part a brisk breeze
from N.W. to S. Batter part light winds from S.
to N.W. steering S.E. & one sail in sight. Employed
in Ship's duty. Lat by Obs 39° 19'. S. Long by Chron 63° 32'. E.

Tuesday Nov 18th

Commences with light airs at N.W. over sail
in sight. Middle and batter part light winds
at N.W. and overcast steering S.E. by E. Nothing
in sight but one sail.
Lat by Obs 39° 17'. S. Long by Chron 66° 37'. E.

Wednesday Nov 19th

Commences with light winds at N.W.
Middle aged. Batter part brisk breeze at
N.W. steering S.E. by E. All drawing sail
set saw nothing. Employed nearly
Lat by Obs 39° 14'. S. Long by Chron 70° 16'. E.
