Thursday Nov 20th

Commences with brisk breeze at WNW steering
SSE. Bottom in sight Middle and Bottom part
the same employed, barely saw Nothing
Lat by Obs 39.08. & Long by Obs 74.44. E.

Friday Nov 21st

Commences with a brisk breeze at WNW
with overcast weather steering SSE. All
downing sail set, Middle part fresh gales at
NW. At 11 part 3 A.M. saw St. Pauls Island
bearing per compass N.E. Dist 8 Miles shortened
sail and luffed by the wind At 12 part 6 A.M.
sent 3 Boats in fishing. Ship laying off and on
under short sail, & fixed the Chronometer in
Error 4th 28. Lat by Obs 39.47. Long corrected by St. Pauls 77.53.

Saturday Nov 22nd

Commences with fresh gales at N Ship off and
on at St. Pauls at 1 P.M. the Boats returned
with a boat 100 fish it being so rugged the
fish would not bite the Boats landed and
found 3 Men on shore left from a fishing
party from the Isd of France the stated that
more was much in want of Bread and tobacco
and they would like to Exchange Potatoes and
fresh Meat it being so rugged to trade could
not improve this opportunity lay off and on
threw the Night at daylight the weather no
better it being thick foggy and blowing a
strong gale at NW. steered SSE and made
All pendant sail, gave Nothing
No Obs

At St. Pauls 1854.

Sunday Nov 23rd

Commences with fresh gales at WNW with thick rain
steering SSE. All downing sail set Middle and
Bottom part set light winds from WNW to SW with
thick foggy and rain No Obs
Lat by account 39.30 & Long by account 81.00 E.

Monday Nov 24th

Commences with light airs Calm with fog and
rain Middle and Bottom part strong gales from
E with thick rainy weather Ship heading to the
Southward under short sail saw Nothing
No Obs Lat by account 39.40 Long account 81.10 E

Tuesday Nov 25th

All the 24 hours strong gales with hard
squalls from Eastward with thick fog and
rain Ship heading to the Southward under
short sail saw Nothing
No Obs Lat by account 40.17. & Long account 81.20 E

Wednesday Nov 26th

Commences with strong gales at SSE. Ship
heading SSE under storm sails Middle
part variable winds from SSE to SW inclining
to moderate Made sail as course required
heading Eastward Bottom part light winds
at SW. steered SSE by S. saw Nothing. Employed
in Ships duty

Lat by Obs 40.08. & Long by Obs 83.39. E

Thursday Nov 27th

Commences with light winds at W steering
SSE by S Middle part light from W to NW. Bottom
part strong breezes at NW steering SSE by S.
All downing sail set saw Nothing
Lat by Obs 40.54. & Long by Obs 87.47 E
