steered Nth Wth All yesterday's sail set. Latter
part fresh breezes at Nth with thick overcast
weather Ship heading Wth Wth saw Nothing
Lat of Obs 51, 34. S. Long & account 65, 00 E

Tuesday January 27th

Commences with strong winds at Nth Wth
with thick rainy weather Ship heading
Wth Middle part strong gales at 8th but lay by
under short sail. At 3 P^m steered Nth Wth and
made all pendant sail. Ends with fresh
gales and squally, saw Nothing
Lat of Obs 50, 00. S. Long & time 164, 27. E

Wednesday January 28th

Commences with fresh gales at 8th steering
Nth Wth saw one Ship. At 4 P^m spoke Ship
William Tell Sayer born 14 Months out of Jean
Middle part strong winds at 8th and squally
steered Sth E. Latter part strong winds at
8th steered Nth E to Nth Wth saw Nothing
Lat of Obs 48, 04. S. Long & time 166, 40. E

Thursday January 29th

Commences with strong winds at 8th Wth
steering Nth at 3 P^m steered Nth E. Middle part
lay by under short at daylight steered Sth E and made
all sail. At 6 A^m saw the Land the Islands of
Moray land bearing per Compass E. Dist 20 Miles
Latter part fresh breezes at Nth with thick
weather steering along the Land saw Nothing
Lat of Obs 47, 37 S. Long & time 168, 17 E.
Long & the Sloop 11, 26. One out the Ship

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Thursday January 30th

Commences with strong winds at Nth steering along
the Land, Middle part strong winds at Nth but under
short sail. steered Nth E. Latter part light sailing
winds from Nth E. with thick rain, saw
Nothing but the Land. No Obs

Lat of account 46, 00. Long & account 169, 10. E

Friday January 31st

Commences with fresh breezes at Nth with
thick weather Ship heading Sth E. Middle
part light winds at 8th steered Nth E. under short
sail. Latter part strong breezes from Sth to Wth
steered Nth E. All sail set saw Nothing
sent up Kane and Mission top gallant yards
Lat of Obs 45, 48. S. Long & time 172, 52. E

Saturday February 1st

Commences with a light winds at 8th Wth
Ship heading Nth E. saw one Ship. Middle
part light winds and calm. Latter part variable
weather. wind at East to Nth E. from a light breeze
to a strong gale took in sail as occasion
required. At 10 P^m part 11. All more Ship headed
Sth E under short sail saw Nothing
No Obs Lat of account 45, 00 S. Long & account 173, 00

Sunday February 2nd

Commences with strong gales at Nth E. Ship
heading Sth E. under short sail. Middle
part strong winds at Nth E. with thick fog
Latter part light winds at Nth Ship standing
on opposite tacks saw Nothing
Lat of Obs 44, 53. S. Long & time 174, 45
