Saturday February 7th

Thursday February 12th
Commences with light winds at E. with
fine weather. Middle part Calms. At 4 P.M.
got under way and sailed round to a Bay & hills
to get Onions and Potatoes. had light winds
and fine pleasant weather got up 3 Tons of Onions

Friday February 13th
Commences with light winds at N. & E. Ship
off and on. 2 Boats on shore trading got
2 tons of Potatoes & 2 tons Onions. Middle part
light winds Latter part light with fine pleasant
weather At 11 A.M. got these trading and put to
sea saw nothing.
