Monday February 16th

Commences with strong winds at N.E. &
and overcast weather. Middle part strong
gales at N.W. Ship under short sail. Latter
part hard gales from W to S.W. Ship under
storm sails most of the time at 11 part 11
A.M. split the Main top sail closed it up
and patch it. Lat 42.45. S. Long of account 175.00. E

Tuesday February 17th

Commences with hard gales at S.W. heading
S with a heavy sea. Ship under storm sails
heading S.E. to E & S. Middle part much the
same. Latter part more moderate at
daylight we bent the Main top sail
repaired and bent it. saw Nothing

Lat of Ch 43.01. S. Long of Choo 176.27. E

Wednesday Feb 18th

Commences with strong winds at S.W.
Ship heading S.W. Latter part fresh breezes
at N.W. steered S.W. saw Nothing but Finbacks
Lat of Ch 43.55. S. Long of Choo 175.45. E

Thursday February 19th

Commences with fresh gales at N.W. steering
S.W. Nothing in sight. Middle part strong winds
at N.W. Ship lay by. Latter part strong winds
at N.W. steered S.W. under short sail saw
Nothing. Lat of Ch 44.54. S. Long of Choo 174.08. E

Friday February 20th

Commences with strong winds at N.W.
steering S.W. Middle part baffling lay by. Latter
part strong gales at S. Ship under short sail
saw Nothing. Lat of Ch 45.16. Long of account 175.00

Saturday February 21st

Commences with hard gales at S.W. Ship
under storm sails heading S. Middle part
much the same. Latter part more moderate
steered East under short sail saw Nothing
but finbacks. Lat of Ch 45.34. S. Long of Choo 175.43. E

Sunday February 22nd

Commences with strong winds at W.
Ship heading N.W. Middle and latter
part baffling with variable winds and weather
accompanied with showers of rain and thunder
saw Nothing. Lat of Ch 44.34. S. Long of Choo 175.27. E

Monday February 23rd

Commences with fresh gales at S.W. Ship
heading W.N.W. under short sail. Middle
part strong gales at S.W. lay by. Latter
part fresh gales at E. steered S by S. saw
Nothing. Lat of Ch 43.54. S. Long of Choo 177.02. E
