

Monday June 21<sup>st</sup>  
Commenced with thick fog, light winds at N  
Ship close to the ice, Middle and Latter part  
the same as usual, saw Nothing but ice and  
2 Ships No Obs. but by account 61,440. A. Long account 177,40

Tuesday June 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Commenced with light winds at N.W. with  
thick fog Ship in a mummy the ice under  
shot & shot Middle part calm with fog at 10  
P.M. had 2 Whales at 11 saw one Whale close to  
the Ship in the fog. Latter part light baffling  
winds from S.W. with fog squalls at 4 P.M.  
A.M. saw one Whale gaining quick power  
to no purpose the fog shut in thick at 11 saw  
2 Whales, power but was obliged to give up  
the Whales on account of the fog.  
Lat & Obs 61,33. A. Long & account 177,55. W

Wednesday June 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Commenced with light winds and calm  
accompanied with thick fog squalls at 3  
P.M. saw one Whale in the fog, power to no  
purpose, Middle and Latter part light winds at  
N.W. with fog squalls at 5. A.M. saw one Whale  
lowered one Boat and fastened to the Whale in  
the fog at 8 the fog lifted saw the Boat fast  
lowered & more Boats at 11. A.M. took the  
Whale a long side a mummy the ice got  
ready for cutting. No Obs.  
Lat & account 61,38. A. Long & account 177,50



Thursday June 24<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with light winds at N.W. with  
fog squalls at 6 P.M. finished cutting the  
Whale had all provident sail to mark the  
Ship out of the ice she being a mummy the  
heavy ice at the time, saw several Whales  
while we were cutting, saw several Whales  
in the course of the night. At 1. A.M. began  
parting and killed at 4. A.M. took the Whale a long  
side & Ship in sight at 4 P.M. commenced  
cutting, ends with thick fog. No Obs.  
Lat & account 61,25. A. Long & account 177,54. W

Friday June 25<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with fresh winds at N.W. with  
thick fog at 1 P.M. finished cutting, cleared up the  
Decks and commenced Drilling, Middle and  
Latter part light winds at S. accompanied with  
thick fog Ship on opposite tack saw several  
Ships. Employed Drilling. No Obs.  
Lat & account 61,36. A. Long the same 178,00 W

Saturday June 26<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with light winds at S. with thick  
fog, Middle part the same Latter part strong  
winds at N. Ship on opposite tack, under  
short sail saw Nothing but Ships. Employed  
Drilling and stowing oil.  
Lat & Obs 61,45. A. Long by Chron 178,17 W.

Sunday June 27<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong winds at N. saw  
several Whales gaining quick didn't lower  
and a plenty of Ships in sight. Employed Drilling  
and stowing oil, Middle and Latter part fresh  
gales at N. saw several Whales to ragged to  
Whales. Employed Drilling and stowing oil.  
No Obs Lat & account 61,50. A. Long & account 178,00 W
