

Monday July 5th
Commences with fine weather Boats off Chasing
Whales to no purpose, about 30 Ships in sight
most of them cutting and boiling, middle part
thick fog. Latter part fine pleasant weather.
Boats of Chasing Whales among the ice fastened to
one Whale, the Whale run for the ice and took the
Line 300 fathoms, followed the Whale as far as
the Boats could penetrate the ice
Lat by Obs 62, 36. N Long by Chron 178, 31. W

Tuesday July 6th
Commences with fine pleasant weather Boats
of Chasing the Whales among the ice, darted to
one Whale to no purpose Middle and Latter parts
thick fog lay by saw Nothing but Ships
Lat by Obs 62, 24. N Long by Chron 178, 34. W

Thursday July 7th
Commences with light gales and thick fog most
of the time saw one Whale close to the Ship
dressed to no purpose spoke Ships Oceanus
5 Whales, Charles Carroll 7, do, do Tuscan 7 Whales
Middle part light winds at S. & E. with fog squalls
Latter part fresh breezes at S. & E. & N. sent the
Boats in to the ice at 10 the fog shut in thick
at 11 A.M. commenced firing for the Boats, ends
with thick fog Boats off from the Ship
No Obs, Lat by magnet 62, 30. N Long by account 178, 40

Wednesday July 8th
Commences with strong gales at S. with fog
firing guns now and then for the Boats at 11
P.M. heard 3 guns from a ship then shot answer them
at 1 P.M. came in contact with Ships Spanus with
my Boats and Men, middle and Latter part
fresh gales at S. with thick fog at 5. A.M. steered
N by W. under short sail saw Nothing but
Ships, Lat by Obs 62, 47. N Long by account 178, 36



Thursday July 9th
Commences with fresh gales at S. with thick
fog steering N by W at 4 P.M. saw a dead
Whale took the Whale a long ride and cut it
in, middle and Latter part strong winds at S. & W.
with thick fog saw Nothing but one Ship Emplaza
Boiling. Lat by Obs 63, 04. N Long by Chron 176, 01. W

Friday July 10th
Commences with strong winds at S. & W.
with thick fog most of the time Nothing
in sight. Emplaza Boiling, Middle part
lay by with thick fog, Latter part strong winds
at S. & W. steered S. & E. thick fog most of the time
saw 2 Ships, Lat 62, 47. N Long 178, 54. W

Sunday July 11th
Commences with fresh winds at S. & W. with
fog squalls steered S. & E. under short sail
Emplaza variously finished Boiling, Middle
part thick fog lay by. Latter part light winds
at S. & W. with fine pleasant weather, steered N
saw 4 Ships, Emplaza stowing oil
Lat by Obs 63, 20. N Long by Chron 179, 14. W

Monday July 12th
Commences with light winds at S. & W. steering
N by W. St Lawrence Island and the Coast of Asia
in sight. Emplaza variously finished stowing
oil Bent the Lanthorn Chain, middle part lay by.
Latter part steered a long the Coast, saw Nothing
but Ships, spoke Ships Magnolia 4 Whales
Almaria 5 Whales.
Lat by Obs 64, 59. N Long 169, 45.
