

Wednesday August 11th
Commences with light winds at N. with fog squalls
steering E & S. all sail set saw Nothing by the Land
and 9 Ships, middle part calm; latter part strong
winds at N. Ship standing on opposite close
to Diamond Islands, saw 15 Ships No Whales,
Employed variously

Thursday August 12th
Commences with strong winds at S. with thick
fog squalls at 2 P.M. steered N.W. under short
sail, middle part variable with fog squalls Ship
lay by under short sail, latter part light winds
at N.W. with a rain storm Ship heading N.E.
saw 3 Ships No Whales but account 6640, S. Long 17000

Friday August 13th
Commences with light winds at N.W. Ship
heading N.E. 2 Ships in sight also the Land
middle and latter part light winds from N.W.
to N.W. Ship heading from N.W. to N.E.
saw Nothing Employed setting a try Pot
but by obs 6725, S. Long by account 16940 W

Saturday August 14th
Commences with light winds at N.W. Ship
heading N.E. Nothing in sight, finished
setting the try Pot middle part calm, latter
fresh winds from E to S. steering along the Land
to the South and Westward on the American side
saw Nothing Employed variously
but by obs 6704, S. Long by account 16650 W

Sunday August 15th
Commences with fresh winds at S. steering from
S.W. to N.W. close in to Point Hope, saw Nothing
middle and latter part fresh winds from S.E. to S.W.
steering N.W. at 5 A.M. spoke Ship George & Wykes
but by obs 6710, S. Long 16800 W

Monday August 16th
Commences with light winds at W. with thick
fog steering N.W. Nothing in sight, middle part
fresh gales at N. Ship lay by under short heading
N.W. latter part light winds at N.W. Ship
heading S.E. all sail set on Ship in sight
but by obs 6746, S. Long by obs 17222 W

Tuesday August 17th
Commences with fresh breezes at N.W. Ship
heading N.E. to E.N.E. at 1 P.M. saw one Whale
that had 2 Irons and run line attached to him
forward and chased to no purpose, middle
and latter part fresh gales at N. Ship heading
E.N.E. under short sail saw Nothing
but by obs 6712, S. Long by account 16900

Wednesday August 18th
Commences with fresh gales at N. Ship heading
E.N.E. under short sail Nothing in sight
middle and latter part strong gales at N. with
more squalls Ship on opposite tack saw
Nothing but one Ship but by obs 6735, S. Long 17150

Thursday August 19th
Commences with
strong gales at N. Nothing in sight, middle and
latter part fresh gales from N.E. to N.W. accompanied
with thick rain squalls Ship heading from
E.N.E. to N.E. saw Nothing
but by obs 6718, S. Long by obs 16815 W
