

Monday August 30th

Commences with light winds at NNE with thick fog Ship heading NW middle part light winds at N with thick fog and rain, latter part calm saw Nothing. Lat by account 68,45. Long 168,15

Tuesday August 31st

Commences with a calm lower down and got 2 Wallerses, saw Nothing, middle and latter part light winds at NE, Ship standing on opposite tack saw Nothing but ice. Lat by account 68,40. Long 171,40. W

Wednesday Sept 1st

Commences with fresh winds at NNE Ship heading E Nothing in sight, middle and latter part strong winds at NNE Ship heading E saw Nothing but the Land off Cape Lishmann Lat by obs 68,22. N Long & time 168,36. W

Thursday Sept 2nd

Commences with fresh gales at NNE Ship heading NW middle part much the same latter part strong winds at ESE Ship heading NE saw Nothing. Lat by obs 69,50. N Long & time 166,30

Friday Sept 3rd

Commences with strong winds at SE steering NE Nothing in sight at 8 PM saw the Land near icy cape shortened sail and came Ship to the Westward middle and latter part strong gales at E Ship heading WNW all prudent sail set saw one Ship Lat by obs 70,04. N Long 164,20 W

Saturday Sept 4th

Commences with strong gales at E with thick weather Ship heading ESE middle and latter part strong gales at E to W Ship standing on opposite tack saw Nothing. Lat by obs 70,13. N Long & time 165,26

Sunday Sept 5th

Commences with strong winds at SW Ship heading ESE middle part light winds at E with thick rain, weather steers W under short sail, latter part fresh gales at ESE Ship heading W saw Nothing. Lat by obs 70,11. N Long & account 166,00

Monday Sept 6th

Commences with fresh gales at ESE Ship heading W Nothing in sight, middle part hailing, latter part fresh breezes at E steering SW saw one Ship Lat by obs 70,06. N Long & time 168,32

Tuesday Sept 7th

Commences with light winds at E with fine pleasant weather steering ESE Nothing in sight, middle and latter part fresh breezes from E to SE Ship heading ESE to ESE saw Nothing No obs thick overcast weather Lat by obs account 68,40. N Long 171,00.

Wednesday Sept 8th

Commences with fresh winds at SE with thick overcast weather Ship heading ESE Nothing in sight, at 4 PM saw 8 Ships at 6 spoke Ship Columbus Brownell 6 Whales, middle part calm, latter part light winds at N with thick fog at 4 PM spoke Ship Moreau Kelly 11 Whales No obs Lat by account 68,36. N Long 171,30. W
