

Thursday Sept 17th

Commences with light winds at N. with thick overcast weather. Boats of Charming Whales to no purpose, Middle and Latter part light winds from N to N.W. with thick misty weather, Ship standing on Opposit tack, saw nothing but Ships, Employed Boiling and raising up shacks.

Friday Sept 18th

Commences with light winds at N.W. with thick overcast weather, Nothing in sight but Ships Middle part Calm, Latter part light winds at S. with thick fog squalls. Ship standing on Opposit tack, saw nothing but Ships, Employed Boiling and stowing down oil.

Saturday Sept 19th

Commences with light winds at S. Nothing in sight, but Ships, finished Boiling and stowing oil Middle and Latter part strong winds from S.W. to W. Ship heading S.W. to S.E. saw nothing.

Sunday Sept 20th

Commences with strong winds at S.W. steering N.W. all fore and aft sail set saw 12 Ships. at sunset shortened sail, Middle and Latter part light winds and Calm, saw nothing but Ships, Employed scraping Bone.

Lat by Obs 64, 15. N. Long by Line 171, 32. W

Monday Sept 21st

Commences with strong winds at S. steering N.W. saw one Whale, did not lower 40 Ships in sight Middle and Latter part strong winds at S. with thick fog most of the time, Ship standing on Opposit tack saw nothing but Ships.

Tuesday Sept 22nd

Commences with light winds at S. one Whale in sight, lowered to no purpose 30 Ships in sight at sunset shortened sail, Middle part strong winds at S.E. Latter part strong gales at S. with thick overcast weather, Ship under short sail heading S. 4 Ships in sight.

No Obs Lat & account 64, 30. N. Long 171, 45. W

Wednesday Sept 23rd

Commences with hard gales at N. with hard squalls, Ship heading S. under storm sails at 7 P.M. wore Ship headed N.W. Middle part hard gales and squalls harder with a heavy cross sea, at 12 Mid Night lost the Mast Boat at 6 A.M. lost the Bow Boat, Latter part hard gales from N. to N.E. with a heavy sea, Ship under storm sails, heading N.W. saw one Ship. Lat by Obs 64, 30. N. Long 171, 40. W

Thursday Sept 24th

Commences with hard gales at N. Ship heading N.W. at 3 P.M. wore Ship headed S. by N. Nothing in sight, Middle and Latter part hard gales and squalls harder from N. Ship under short sail, saw one Ship.
