Commences with strong gales at N. with rain. Ship heading E. N. E. under storm sails. Nothing in sight. Middle part variable. Latter part light winds at N. E. with thick fog and rain. Ship heading E. N. E. saw one ship, employed clearing up and repairing. Damaged. No obs.

E. dist 10 Miles. made all pendant sail and steered a long the coast to the eastward. 10 ships in sight.

Made all pendant sail at 11 A.M. part East Cape dist 2 Miles. 8 ships in sight steering for the Cape. No obs.

Commences with strong winds at N. steering per compass S. a long the coast. 8 ships in sight. Employed variously. Middle and latter part fresh gales at N. E. and thick overcast weather with light squalls of snow. steering per compass S. to S. W. all pendant sail set at 8 A.M. part St. Lawrence Island dist 5 Miles one ship in sight. No obs.
