

Sunday Oct 3rd

Commences with fresh gales at N.W. with thick snow squalls steering for Cape Pass S.W. & all pendant sail set one ship in middle part much the same latter part light hailing with calm ship marking to the S.W. the Canada in sight
Lat by Obs 56.01. N. Long by Chron 145.45. W

Monday Oct 4th

Commences with strong winds at W. with hard squalls and thick snow, ship heading S.W. all pendant sail set & ship in sight, middle and latter part strong gales at W.N.W. with hard squalls of hail and snow, ship heading S.W. with all pendant sail set saw nothing
Lat by Obs 54.16. N. Long by Chron 148.00. W

Tuesday Oct 5th

Commences with strong winds at W.N.W. and squalls, ship heading S.W. & ship in sight, middle part calm, latter part light winds at S.E. at daylight saw Stone Island bearing for compass S.E. dist 40 miles, ship heading S. all sail set & ship in sight, employed variously.

Wednesday Oct 6th

Commences with hailing winds at S.E. and calm & ship in sight and the land, middle part variable latter part strong winds at S.E. ship heading S. all pendant sail set saw nothing but ship
Lat by Obs 51.17. N. Long by Chron 148.30. W

Thursday Oct 7th

Commences with strong gales at S. with thick weather ship heading S.E. saw one ship middle part head gales at S. with thick fog and rain, ship under stern sails, latter part strong gales at S. with thick fog and rain, ship heading S.E. all pendant sail set nothing in sight No Obs
Lat by account 49.40. N. Long 148.40. W

Friday Oct 8th

Commences with strong gales at S. with fog and rain, ship heading S.E. middle part the same latter part fresh gales at N.E. with fog and rain squalls, steered S.E. all pendant sail set saw nothing, on bent the Main Top Gallant Sail and repaired it and bent it
Lat by Obs 48.36. N. Long 147.41. W

Saturday Oct 9th

Commences with fresh gales at N.E. with fog and rain squalls, steered S.E. all sail set, middle and latter part much the same saw 2 ships
Lat by Obs 45.43. N. Long 145.35. W

Sunday Oct 10th

Commences with fresh gales at S.E. with rain squalls, steering S.E. all drawing sail set, middle and latter part light winds at N.W. with rain squalls, steered S.E. all drawing sail set saw nothing, Lat by Obs 42.31. N. Long by Chron 141.40. W

Monday Oct 11th

All this 24 hours strong breezes at N.W. and squalls steering S.E. all drawing sail set, nothing in sight, employed cleaning ship
Lat by Obs 41.34. N. Long 144.03. W
