 shortened sail and lay by on opposite tacks
 at daylight saw the Island of Monowai bearing
 S Dist 30 Mib. steered from S S W to S W all sail
 set saw one Ship Employed heading chains
 Lat 46° 21' 14" N. Long 159° 57' 59" W
 true Long 156° 50' W

Monday Oct 25th
 Commenced with light winds at 8 A.M. steering
 W by S. all sail set close to Monowai at 6 P.M.
 saw Whakoo Dist 30 Mib, Middle and Lutter
 part fine weather at 9 A.M. took a Pilot
 4th Anchor in Whakoo Harbour, Employed surely

 Commenced with fine weather At 2 P.M. 4th

 surely

Saturday Oct 30th
 fine weather and very light wind from
 the Eastward, Employed surely

 fine pleasant weather and very light winds
 from the Westward

Monday Nov 1st
 very light with light winds from the
 Westward Employed surely
