 light winds at N. Ship heading W.S.W. the Islands in
 sight. Employed variously.

Sunday Nov 7th
 Commences with light winds at N. Ship heading
 W.S.W. the Islands in sight, middle and latter part
 light winds at E. with fine pleasant weather. Ship
 lay by close to the Island of Atavi, saw 20 Ship
 Lat by Obs 21.48 N. Long by Chron 154.59 W
 by Syner 154.12

Monday Nov 8th
 Commences with light winds at E. with
 pleasant weather Ship up and on, middle and
 latter part the same. At 9 A.M. I went on shore
 to trade at Atavi.

Tuesday Nov 9th
 Commences with baffling winds and rain squalls
 At 2 P.M. I returned from shore with all the recruits
 that could be obtained, middle and latter part baffling
 winds and Calms accompanied with Thunder and
 lightning and showers of rain, Ship close to the Land
 Employed variously.
 Lat by Obs 21.10 N. Long by Chron 154.42

Wednesday Nov 10th
 Commences with a calm Ship close to the Land
 Employed cleaning Chain cables, middle and latter
 part light winds at E. N.E. to E. Ship heading N
 to N.E. saw nothing but the Islands. Employed
 variously, oiling the Chain cables and stowing them
 below fitting Boats &c
 Lat by Obs 23.33 N. Long by Chron 154.38 W

Thursday Nov 11th
 All the 24 hours light airs at E with fine
 pleasant weather Ship heading N.E. saw
 nothing. Employed variously, finished oiling
 Chimes repairing Boats fitting Cutters gear
 &c &c.
 Lat by Obs 24.28 N. Long by Chron 154.39

Friday Nov 12th
 Commences with light airs at E. Ship heading
 N.E. middle and latter part calm saw nothing
 Employed variously, working and fitting Boats &c
 Lat by Obs 24.34 N. Long by Chron 154.02 W

Saturday Nov 13th
 Commences with a calm middle part the same
 latter part light winds at W with now and then
 a rain squall, steered N.E. by E. saw nothing
 Employed painting Boats. At 6 P.M.
 Lat by account 24.45 N. Long 154.35 W

Sunday Nov 14th
 Commences with light winds at W with fine
 pleasant weather middle and latter part
 much the same saw nothing, steered N.E. by E
 Lat by Obs 25.10 N. Long by account 154.10
