Lat by account 52.00. N. Long 178.00. W

Thursday April 28<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with hard gales at S.E. with a thick  
rain storm. Ship under storm sails. heading S  
Middle part the same. Latter strong gales at W.N.W.  
Ship heading N.W. under storm sail. saw Nothing  
Lat by Obs 51.53. N. Long by Obs 176.38. W

Friday April 29<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with strong gales at W.N.W. at 1 P.M.  
steered N.W. all prudent sail set. Middle part  
the same. Latter part fresh breezes at W.N.W. Ship  
heading N. saw 2 Humpback Whales  
Lat by Obs 53.34. N. Long by Obs 176.04. W

Saturday April 30<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with fresh breezes at N.W. Ship heading  
N.E. Middle part light and huffing. Latter part light  
winds at N. Ship heading W.N.W. the Coast of Newfoundland
