 Commences with fresh gales at N.E. with thick weather
 Ship heading S. Middle and latter part strong gales
 at N.E. Ship under short sail standing on Opposite
 tack. saw one ship. No obs
 Lat by account 57.00 N. Long 145.00 W

Saturday May 7th
 Commences with fresh gales at N.E. with thick
 weather. Middle and latter part the same. Ship standing
 on Opposite tack. saw several ships.
 No obs Lat by account 57.15 N. Long 145.20 W

Sunday May 8th
 Commences with strong gales at N.E. with a
 thick snow storm. Middle and latter part the
 same. Ship standing on Opposite tack. saw nothing.
 No obs Lat by account 56.50 N. Long 145.04 W

Monday May 9th
 Commences with hard gales from N.E. with
 a snow storm. Ship heading S. under storm sails
 Middle and latter part hard gales from N.E. to
 N.W. with snow and rain. saw nothing. No obs
 Lat by account 56.38 N. Long 143.00 W

Tuesday May 10th
 Commences with strong gales at N.W. with
 thick snow weather. Middle part much
 the same. Latter part more moderate winds
 N.W. Ship heading N.E. 3 ships in sight at 8
 A.M. spoke Ship Capt. Howland. Nothing this noon
