Commences with light winds at N.W. Ship heading
N.E. 3 Ships in sight, Middle and latter part light
baffling air and Calm 14 Ships in sight.

Thursday May 12th
Commences with light winds at S. N.E. Ship
heading N. 12 Ships in sight, Middle and latter
part fresh breezes from S. N.E. to N.E. Ship heading
N. to N.W. saw Nothing but Ships
Lat by Obs 54.32. N. Long by account 140.40

Friday May 13th
Commences with light winds at N.W. Ship
heading N.W. Middle part Calm latter part light
winds from S.W. to W. Ship heading N.W. to N.
saw the Land bearing N. to E. 5 Ships in sight 3 with
the Boats down. saw one or two Finbacks.

Lat by Obs 54.06. Long by Chron 140.35. W.
At 5 P.M. spoke Ship named Fish. Nothing this season

Saturday May 14th
Commences with light baffling winds, the Land
in sight East 25 Miles. 5 Ships in sight no Whales
middle part strong winds at S. Ship under start
sail. spoke Ships Columbus & Indian Chief
of New London Nothing latter part strong
winds at S heading S.E. saw Nothing but Ships
Lat by Obs 54.46 N. Long by Chron 141.14. W.

Sunday May 15th
Commences with strong winds at S. N.E. Ship
heading S.E. Nothing in sight, Middle and latter
part strong winds from N.E. Ship heading S.E.
a thick snow storm most of the time. saw one
Ship. No Ob Lat by & account 57.20. N. Long 148.20. W.

Monday May 16th
Commences with strong winds at S. N.E. over Ship in
sight, Middle and latter part light winds from
N.E. to N. at 10 A.M. saw one or two Whales, but not
used. saw Nothing more.
Lat by Obs 58.47. N. Long by account 147.40.

Tuesday May 17th
Commences with light winds at N.W. the Boats
off fast to the Whale hauling him up, it being
a sinking Whale. at 4 P.M. took the Whale a long
ride at 6 Commenced cutting at 10 fathoms, Middle
and latter part light winds at N.W. Ship heading N.E.
saw Nothing. employed variously fitting Boats clearing
up started the mackerel &c.

Wednesday May 18th
Commences with light winds at N.W. Ship heading
N.W. Nothing in sight. employed Bailing
Middle and latter part much the same.

Lat by Obs 54.12 N. Long by Chron 144.51. W.

Thursday May 19th
Commences with light winds at W. steering
N.E. one Ship in sight. employed Bailing
middle and latter part light winds from N.W. to
N.E. Ship working to the North and Eastward spoke
Ship Caronahane Nothing this season. finished Bailing
plenty of ice in sight.

Friday May 20th
Commences with light winds at N.E. 6 Ships in
sight Middle and latter part light baffling winds
Ship working to the North, saw one Ship Boats fast
to a Whale. Nothing in sight but Ships and ice
employed stowing down oil.
